6 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING A \$5,000,000.00
7 FISCAL YEAR 2020 COPS HIRING PROGRAM GRANT (THE
8 "GRANT") FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE
9 ("DOJ") / OFFICE OF COMMUNITY ORIENTED POLICING
10 SERVICES ("COPS") AND APPROPRIATING \$749,151.52
11 TO COVER THE REQUIRED LOCAL MATCH FROM THE CITY
12 OF JACKSONVILLE (THE "CITY") FOR THE FIRST YEAR
13 OF THE GRANT AND ADDITIONAL OPERATING EXPENSES
14 TO TRAIN AND OUTFIT FORTY (40) NEW POLICE
15 OFFICER POSITIONS WITHIN THE JACKSONVILLE
16 SHERIFF'S OFFICE TO BE HIRED UNDER THE GRANT, AS
17 INITIATED BY B.T. 21-025; AUTHORIZING SAID
18 POSITIONS, AS INITIATED BY R.C. 21-038;
19 APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS
20 DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY, TO
21 EXECUTE AND DELIVER THAT CERTAIN COPS HIRING
22 PROGRAM GRANT AWARD DOCUMENT (AWARD NUMBER
23 2020ULWX0031) BETWEEN DOJ/COPS AND THE CITY OF
24 JACKSONVILLE; PROVIDING FOR CITY OVERSIGHT BY
25 THE JACKSONVILLE SHERIFF'S OFFICE; PROVIDING AN
26 EFFECTIVE DATE.

28 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

29 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2020-2021 fiscal year,
30 within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated
31 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)

1 listed in subsection (b):

8 (c) Explanation of Appropriation

9 The funding above is a \$5,000,000.00 grant from the U.S.
10 Department of Justice / Office of Community Oriented
11 Policing Services, with an additional appropriation of
12 \$749,151.52 from the City to cover the required local match
13 for the first year of the Grant and additional operating
14 expenses to outfit and train the forty (40) new police
15 officers hired under the Grant.

16 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
17 Section 1 is to fund forty (40) full-time police officer positions
18 within the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office for the Grant period
19 beginning July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2023 (the "Grant Term"). A
20 copy of the COPS Hiring Program Grant Award letter is attached hereto
21 as **Exhibit 2** and incorporated herein by this reference.

22 **Section 3. Authorization of Positions.** There are hereby
23 authorized the positions more fully described in R.C. 21-038, attached
24 hereto as **Exhibit 3** and incorporated herein by this reference.

25 **Section 4. Approval and Authorization.** There is hereby
26 approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation
27 Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver, for and on
28 behalf of the City, that certain COPS Hiring Program Grant Award
29 Document (Award Number 2020ULWX0031) between DOJ/COPS and the City
30 of Jacksonville, substantially in the form placed **On File** with the
31 Office of Legislative Services. The Grant requires a local match

1 from the City in the total amount of \$2,241,550.00 during the Grant
2 Term, of which \$749,151.52 is being appropriated pursuant to this
3 ordinance to cover the City's match for the first year of the Grant
4 Term (July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2021) and additional operating
5 expenses to outfit and train the forty (40) new full-time police
6 officers hired under the Grant.

7 **Section 5. Oversight Department.** The Jacksonville
8 Sheriff's Office shall oversee administration of the Grant.

9 **Section 6. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become
10 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
11 without the Mayor's signature.
