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ORDINANCE 2020-706-E

AN ORDINANCE REAFFIRMING THE NEIGHBORHOOD ASSESSMENT PROGRAM (NAP) FOR THE ORTEGA POINT NORTH NEIGHBORHOOD, AS APPROVED BY ORDINANCE 2019-376-E, FOR UNDERGROUND POWER AND COMMUNICATIONS IMPROVEMENTS, PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 714 (NEIGHBORHOOD ASSESSMENT PROGRAMS), PART 3 (UNDERGROUND POWER AND COMMUNICATIONS PROGRAM AREA), ORDINANCE CODE; REAFFIRMING INTENT TO USE THE UNIFORM METHOD FOR NON-AD VALOREM ASSESSMENTS, PURSUANT TO SECTION 197.3632, FLORIDA STATUTES; DIRECTING DISTRIBUTION OF THIS ORDINANCE BY LEGISLATIVE SERVICES; REQUESTING ONE CYCLE EMERGENCY PASSAGE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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WHEREAS, the Council approved a Neighborhood Assessment Program (NAP) for the Ortega Point North Neighborhood for Underground Power and Communications Improvements, pursuant to Chapter 714 (Neighborhood Assessment Programs), Part 3 (Underground Power and Communications Program Area), Ordinance Code, by Ordinance 2019-376-E on June 25, 2019; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2019-376-E states that the Council shall adopt the non-ad valorem assessment roll for the Ortega Point North NAP by September 15, 2020; however, the project is still under construction; and

WHEREAS, the estimated completion date for the project is Spring

2021, and the Council wishes to reaffirm its intent to use the uniform method for the levy, collection and enforcement of non-ad valorem assessments for the Ortega Point North NAP to ensure compliance with Section 197.3632, Florida Statutes, for consideration of the non-ad valorem assessment roll in 2021; now, therefore

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BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Reaffirming the Ortega Point North NAP. Pursuant to Chapter 714 (Neighborhood Assessment Programs), Part 3 (Underground Power and Communications Program Area), Ordinance Code, the Council hereby reaffirms the Ortega Point North NAP, for Underground Power and Communications Improvements, pursuant to Chapter 714 (Neighborhood Assessment Programs), Part 3 (Underground Power and Communications Program Area), Ordinance Code, as approved by Ordinance 2019-376-E on June 25, 2019.

Reaffirming Intent to Use the Uniform Method for Section 2. the Levy, Collection, and Enforcement of Non-Ad Valorem Assessments. Pursuant to Section 197.3632(3)(a), Florida Statutes, the Council hereby reaffirms its intent to use the uniform method for the levy, collection, and enforcement of non-ad valorem assessments pursuant to the Ortega Point North NAP. This levy is necessary to reimburse JEA for the initial funding of the Underground Power and Communication Improvements, as described in Ordinance 2019-376-E. description of the boundaries of the real property subject to the levy is included in Ordinance 2019-376-E. Pursuant to Section 197.3632(4), Florida Statutes, the Council shall adopt the non-ad valorem assessment roll at a public hearing between January 1st and September 15th for inclusion on the annual tax bill, subject to any deadlines established by the Property Appraiser and the Tax Collector. This Ordinance shall serve as the Resolution required by Section 197.3632(3)(a), Florida Statutes.

Section 3. Distribution by Legislative Services. Pursuant

to Section 197.3632(3)(a), Florida Statutes, Legislative Services is hereby directed to mail a copy of this Ordinance, as enacted, to the Property Appraiser, the Tax Collector, and the State of Florida Department of Revenue, Property Tax Oversight Division.

Section 4. Requesting One Cycle Emergency Passage Pursuant to Council Rule 4.901 Emergency. One cycle emergency passage of this legislation is requested. The nature of the emergency is that Section 197.3632(3)(a), Florida Statutes, requires adoption of legislation stating the intent to use the uniform method for collecting a non-ad valorem assessment prior to January 1st.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
