ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING A \$450,000.00 AN TRANSITIONAL HOUSING ASSISTANCE GRANT FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, OFFICE ON VIOLENCE AGAINST WOMEN, WITH NO LOCAL MATCH, TO PROVIDE TRANSITIONAL HOUSING ASSISTANCE AND SUPPORTIVE SERVICES TO VICTIMS OF CERTAIN TYPES OF CRIMES, AS INITIATED BY REVISED B.T. 21-009; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AND CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER CONTRACTS WITH CHANGING HOMELESSNESS, INC., HUBBARD HOUSE, INC., AND OTHER QUALIFIED LOCAL SERVICE PROVIDERS WHO WILL PARTNER WITH THE CITY TO PROVIDE THE SERVICES DESCRIBED IN THIS ORDINANCE; INVOKING THE EXCEPTION OF SECTION 126.107(G)(EXEMPTIONS), PART 1 (GENERAL REGULATIONS), CHAPTER 126 (PROCUREMENT CODE), ORDINANCE CODE, REGARDING THE SERVICES TO BE PROVIDED BY CHANGING HOMELESSNESS, INC. AND HUBBARD HOUSE, INC.; PROVIDING FOR CITY OVERSIGHT BY THE PARKS, RECREATION AND

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COMMUNITY SERVICES DEPARTMENT, SOCIAL SERVICES DIVISION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

(c) Explanation of Appropriation

The funding above is a Transitional Housing Assistance Program grant (the "Grant") from the U.S. Department of Justice, Office on Violence Against Women, with no local match.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to fund the provision of transitional housing and supportive services to victims of domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault, stalking and human trafficking during the grant period beginning October 1, 2020 through September 30, 2023. These services will assist victims of these crimes in transitioning from homelessness to permanent housing and are anticipated to continue for a minimum period of six months up to twenty-four months per client. Additionally, the grant will be marketed to target clients who are disabled, specifically those who are deaf or hard-of-hearing. A copy of the Grant Award has been placed On File 1

with the Office of Legislative Services.

Section 3. Approval and authorization to execute. Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver contracts with Changing Homelessness, Inc., Hubbard House, Inc., and other qualified local provider agencies who will partner with the City to provide the services described in this ordinance.

Invoking the exception to Section 126.107(g), Section 4. Ordinance Code. The City of Jacksonville is hereby authorized to directly procure the use of the professional services of Changing Homelessness, Inc. and Hubbard House, Inc. to provide services as more particularly described in Section 2. Pursuant to Section 126.107(g) (Exemptions), Part 1 (General Regulations), Chapter 126 (Procurement Code), Ordinance Code, such procurement is exempted from competitive solicitation because the supplies or services are to be provided by those specifically prescribed within authorizing legislation that appropriates the same. With the exception of the foregoing, all other provisions of Chapter 126, Ordinance Code, shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 5. Oversight Department. The Parks, Recreation and Community Services Department, Social Services Division, shall oversee administration of the grant.

Section 6. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
