AN ORDINANCE REZONING APPROXIMATELY 0.23± OF AN ACRE, LOCATED IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 7 AT 2821 LIBERTY STREET NORTH, BETWEEN 18<sup>TH</sup> STREET EAST AND  $19^{\text{TH}}$  STREET EAST (R.E. NO. 044627-0000), AS DESCRIBED HEREIN, OWNED BY JOHN EDWARD ZEDIAK, FROM INDUSTRIAL BUSINESS PARK (IBP) DISTRICT TO PLANNED UNIT DEVELOPMENT (PUD) DISTRICT, AS DEFINED AND CLASSIFIED UNDER THE ZONING CODE, TO PERMIT COMMERCIAL USES, AS DESCRIBED IN THE 2821 LIBERTY STREET PUD; Ν. PROVIDING Α DISCLAIMER THAT THE REZONING GRANTED HEREIN SHALL NOT BE CONSTRUED AS AN EXEMPTION FROM ANY OTHER APPLICABLE LAWS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

20 WHEREAS, John Edward Zediak, the owner of approximately 0.23± 21 of an acre, located in Council District 7 at 2821 Liberty Street North, between 18th Street East and 19th Street East (R.E. No. 22 044627-0000), as more particularly described in Exhibit 1, dated 23 24 August 17, 2020, and graphically depicted in **Exhibit 2**, both of 25 which are attached hereto (Subject Property), has applied for a 26 rezoning and reclassification of that property from Industrial 27 Business Park (IBP) District to Planned Unit Development (PUD) District, as described in Section 1 below; and 28

29 WHEREAS, the Planning Commission has considered the 30 application and has rendered an advisory opinion; and

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WHEREAS, the Land Use and Zoning Committee, after due notice

and public hearing, has made its recommendation to the Council; and

2 WHEREAS, the Council finds that such rezoning is: (1) 3 consistent with the 2030 Comprehensive Plan; (2) furthers the 4 goals, objectives and policies of the 2030 Comprehensive Plan; and 5 (3) is not in conflict with any portion of the City's land use 6 regulations; and

7 WHEREAS, the Council finds the proposed rezoning does not adversely affect the orderly development of the City as embodied in 8 9 the Zoning Code; will not adversely affect the health and safety of 10 residents in the area; will not be detrimental to the natural environment or to the use or development of the adjacent properties 11 in the general neighborhood; and will accomplish the objectives and 12 meet the standards of Section 656.340 (Planned Unit Development) of 13 the Zoning Code; now, therefore 14

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BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Property Rezoned. The Subject Property is hereby rezoned and reclassified from Industrial Business Park (IBP) District to Planned Unit Development (PUD) District. This new PUD district shall generally permit commercial uses, and is described, shown and subject to the following documents, attached hereto:

30 Section 3. Disclaimer. The rezoning granted herein 31 shall not be construed as an exemption from any other applicable

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local, state, or federal laws, regulations, requirements, permits 1 2 or approvals. All other applicable local, state or federal permits 3 or approvals shall be obtained before commencement of the development or use and issuance of this rezoning is based upon 4 acknowledgement, representation and confirmation made 5 by the applicant(s), owner(s), developer(s) and/or any authorized agent(s) 6 7 or designee(s) that the subject business, development and/or use will be operated in strict compliance with all laws. Issuance of 8 9 this rezoning does **not** approve, promote or condone any practice or 10 act that is prohibited or restricted by any federal, state or local 11 laws.

12 Section 4. Effective Date. The enactment of this 13 Ordinance shall be deemed to constitute a quasi-judicial action of 14 the City Council and shall become effective upon signature by the 15 Council President and the Council Secretary.
