Type of Action: Authorizing Mayoral execution of a License Agreement; providing oversight

Bill Summary: The bill authorizes the Administration to execute a license agreement between the City of Jacksonville and Managed Access to Child Health, Inc., authorizing the licensee to use and occupy approximately 6,352 square feet of office space in the Kids Hope Alliance building located at 1095 A. Philip Randolph Blvd., Jacksonville, Florida 32206. The Kids Hope Alliance will be responsible for oversight of the license on behalf of the City.

Background Information: The Kids Hope Alliance has three additional contracts with Managed Access to Child Health, Inc. The purpose of providing no cost rent is to allow for the funds to be used for services that directly impact the children that are being serviced. The rented space will be used as office space to support the licensee's administration of certain children's services and programming pursuant to various contracts between the licensee and KHA at no cost to the Licensee. The License provides for an initial term commencing on the effective date of the license and terminating on the earlier of the expiration or termination of all Services Contracts, or on the fifth anniversary of the license effective date.

Policy Impact Area: Kids Hope Alliance, children services

Fiscal Impact: The request has no appropriation or deappropriation of funds because the cost of rent is \$0.00 and the lease will become effective February 1, 2021.
