AN ORDINANCE REZONING APPROXIMATELY 1.28± ACRES, LOCATED IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 4 AT 1909 PARENTAL HOME ROAD, BETWEEN HOGAN ROAD AND PARENTAL CIRCLE (R.E. NO. 137008-0020) AS DESCRIBED HEREIN, OWNED BY RCW PROPERTIES, INC., FROM PLANNED UNIT DEVELOPMENT (PUD) DISTRICT (2018-669-E) TO PLANNED UNIT DEVELOPMENT (PUD) DISTRICT, AS DEFINED AND CLASSIFIED UNDER THE ZONING CODE, TO PERMIT COMMERCIAL USES, AS DESCRIBED IN THE 1909 PARENTAL HOME ROAD COMMERCIAL DEVELOPMENT PUD; PROVIDING Α DISCLAIMER THAT THE REZONING GRANTED HEREIN SHALL NOT BE CONSTRUED AS AN EXEMPTION FROM ANY OTHER APPLICABLE LAWS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

21 WHEREAS, RCW Properties, Inc., the owner of approximately 1.28± 22 acres, located in Council District 4 at 1909 Parental Home Road, 23 between Hogan Road and Parental Circle (R.E. No. 137008-0020), as 24 more particularly described in **Exhibit 1**, dated September 12, 2018, 25 and graphically depicted in Exhibit 2, both of which are attached 26 **hereto** (Subject Property), has applied for a rezoning and 27 reclassification of that property from Planned Unit Development (PUD) District (2018-669-E) to Planned Unit Development (PUD) District, as 28 29 described in Section 1 below; and

30 WHEREAS, the Planning Commission has considered the application 31 and has rendered an advisory opinion; and WHEREAS, the Land Use and Zoning Committee, after due notice and public hearing, has made its recommendation to the Council; and

WHEREAS, the Council finds that such rezoning is: (1) consistent with the 2030 Comprehensive Plan; (2) furthers the goals, objectives and policies of the 2030 Comprehensive Plan; and (3) is not in conflict with any portion of the City's land use regulations; and

7 WHEREAS, the Council finds the proposed rezoning does not adversely affect the orderly development of the City as embodied in 8 9 the Zoning Code; will not adversely affect the health and safety of 10 residents in the area; will not be detrimental to the natural environment or to the use or development of the adjacent properties 11 in the general neighborhood; and will accomplish the objectives and 12 meet the standards of Section 656.340 (Planned Unit Development) of 13 the Zoning Code; now, therefore 14

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Property Rezoned. The Subject Property is hereby rezoned and reclassified from Planned Unit Development (PUD) District (2018-669-E) to Planned Unit Development (PUD) District. This new PUD district shall generally permit commercial uses, and is described, shown and subject to the following documents, attached hereto:

All other applicable local, state or federal permits or approvals shall be obtained before commencement of the development 3 or use and issuance of this rezoning is based upon acknowledgement, 4 5 representation and confirmation made by the applicant(s), owner(s), developer(s) and/or any authorized agent(s) or designee(s) that the 6 7 subject business, development and/or use will be operated in strict compliance with all laws. Issuance of this rezoning does not approve, 8 9 promote or condone any practice or act that is prohibited or 10 restricted by any federal, state or local laws.

Section 4. Effective Date. The enactment of this Ordinance shall be deemed to constitute a quasi-judicial action of the City Council and shall become effective upon signature by the Council President and the Council Secretary.
