QUITCLAIM DEED

THIS INDENTURE, made this ____ day of _____, 20 ____, by the **CITY OF JACKSONVILLE**, a municipal corporation under the laws of the State of Florida, ("Grantor"), and **GATEWAY COMMUNITY SERVICES, INC.**, a Florida not-for-profit corporation, whose business address is 555 Stockton Street, Jacksonville, Florida, 32204 ("Grantee");

WITNESSETH:

THAT Grantor, for and in consideration of the sum of (\$1.00) One Dollar and other good and valuable consideration paid by the Grantee, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, releases, remises and quitclaims to Grantee, its successors and assigns forever, all of Grantor's right, title, and interest in and to the following described lands, situate, lying and being in the County of Duval, State of Florida, to wit:

See Exhibit "A", attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference.

SUBJECT to any easements, reservations, leases, conditions, licenses, and restrictions, known or unknown or whether or not of record. This conveyance is specifically and expressly without any warranties, representations or guarantees either express or implied, of any kind, nature, or type whatsoever, from or on behalf of the Grantor, including but not limited to warranties of title, suitability or merchantability.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same together with all and singular the appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, and all the estate, right, title, interest, lien, equity and claim whatsoever of Grantor, either in law or equity, to the only proper use, benefit and behoof of Grantee, its successors and assigns forever.

RESERVING to Grantor a right of reentry should the property cease to be used for behavioral health care services furthering Grantee's mission to provide effective treatment and recovery services for adults and adolescents suffering addiction and related mental health issues in Northeast Florida. If the property ceases to be used for these purposes, or if Grantee fails to timely submit to the City the annual affidavit required pursuant to City of Jacksonville Ordinance 2020-618-E, then Grantor shall have the right but not the duty, to reenter the property and all right, title and interest in the property shall revert to City. If City reenters the property then, at Grantor's request, Grantee shall execute its special warranty deed to Grantor conveying the property to Grantor free of all liens and encumbrances.
