4 **RESOLUTION 2020-696-D**

5 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE,
6 FLORIDA, STATING ITS INTENT TO USE THE UNIFORM
7 METHOD FOR THE LEVY, COLLECTION, AND
8 ENFORCEMENT OF A NON-AD VALOREM ASSESSMENT,
9 PURSUANT TO SECTION 197.3632, FLORIDA
10 STATUTES, FOR CERTAIN RESIDENTIAL SOLID WASTE
11 COLLECTION SERVICES WITHIN THE GENERAL
12 SERVICES DISTRICT OF THE CONSOLIDATED CITY OF
13 JACKSONVILLE, EXCLUDING URBAN SERVICES
14 DISTRICTS 2, 3, 4 AND 5, AS AUTHORIZED BY, AND
15 DEFINED IN, CHAPTER 382 AND CHAPTER 715,
16 ORDINANCE CODE, AND ORDINANCES 2010-446-E AND
17 2010-673-E; STATING THE NEED FOR SUCH LEVY;
18 DIRECTING DISTRIBUTION OF THIS RESOLUTION TO
19 THE PROPERTY APPRAISER, TAX COLLECTOR, AND THE
20 STATE OF FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE,
21 PROPERTY TAX OVERSIGHT DIVISION; AND PROVIDING
22 AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

24 **WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 197.3632, *Florida Statutes*, the
25 City of Jacksonville is authorized to use the uniform method for
26 the levy, collection, and enforcement of non-ad valorem
27 assessments; and

28 **WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 197.3632, *Florida Statutes*, a
29 local government shall adopt a resolution stating its intent to use
30 the uniform method for the levy, collection, and enforcement of a

1 non-ad valorem assessment; and

2 **WHEREAS**, notice of the City of Jacksonville's intent to use
3 the uniform method for the levy, collection, and enforcement of a
4 non-ad valorem assessment, as described herein, has been published
5 pursuant to Section 197.3632, *Florida Statutes*, and the required
6 public hearing has been held; now, therefore

7 **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

8 **Section 1. Statement of Intent and Legal Description.**

9 The City of Jacksonville hereby states its intent to use the
10 uniform method for the levy, collection, and enforcement of a non-
11 ad valorem assessment for certain residential solid waste
12 collection services, commencing January 1, 2021, as authorized by,
13 and defined in, Chapter 382 and Chapter 715, *Ordinance Code*, and
14 Ordinances 2010-446-E and 2010-673-E. The legal description of the
15 area subject to such non-ad valorem assessment is the General
16 Services District of the consolidated City of Jacksonville, as
17 defined in Section 7.16, *Florida Statutes*, and Article 2 of the
18 Charter of the City of Jacksonville, less and except Urban Services
19 Districts 2, 3, 4 and 5, also known as the Cities of Jacksonville
20 Beach, Atlantic Beach, and Neptune Beach and the Town of Baldwin,
21 as more particularly described in the Charters of such local
22 governments, and incorporated herein by reference.

23 **Section 2. Statement of Need.** The City of Jacksonville

24 hereby states the need for a non-ad valorem assessment for certain
25 residential solid waste collection services, as authorized by, and
26 defined in, Chapter 382 and Chapter 715, *Ordinance Code*, and
27 Ordinances 2010-446-E and 2010-673-E, to fund the cost of providing
28 such certain residential solid waste collection services, and the
29 uniform method for the levy, collection, and enforcement of such a
30 non-ad valorem assessment is the most efficient and cost effective
31 method of collection of all the collection options that may be

1 available to the City of Jacksonville.

2 **Section 3. Distribution by Legislative Services.**

3 Pursuant to Section 197.3632(3)(a), *Florida Statutes*, Legislative
4 Services is hereby directed to mail a copy of this Resolution, as
5 adopted, to the Property Appraiser, the Tax Collector, and the
6 State of Florida Department of Revenue, Property Tax Oversight
7 Division.

8 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall become

9 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
10 without the Mayor's signature.
