AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$248,850.00 (\$186,637.50 FROM THE FEDERAL **EMERGENCY** MANAGEMENT AGENCY THROUGH THE FLORIDA DIVISION OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT ("FDEM") AND A 25% LOCAL MATCH OF \$62,212.50 FROM JEFFREY M. WELLER, THE OWNER OF THE SUBJECT PROPERTY) UNDER THE HAZARD MITIGATION GRANT PROGRAM TO FUND THE ELEVATION OF A PRIVATE RESIDENTIAL STRUCTURE LOCATED AT 13410 EYNON JACKSONVILLE, FLORIDA 32258, AS INITIATED BY REVISED B.T. 21-018; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY, TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER, FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE CITY THAT CERTAIN FEDERALLY-FUNDED SUBAWARD AND GRANT AGREEMENT NUMBER H0433 BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE (THE "CITY") AND FDEM, AND THAT CERTAIN HAZARD MITIGATION ASSISTANCE GRANT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY AND JEFFREY M. WELLER; PROVIDING FOR CITY OVERSIGHT BY THE JACKSONVILLE FIRE AND RESCUE DEPARTMENT, EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS DIVISION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2020-2021 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

The funding above represents a Hazard Mitigation Grant Program ("HMGP") award in the amount of \$186,637.50 from the Federal Emergency Management Agency ("FEMA") through the State of Florida Division of Emergency Management ("FDEM") plus a 25% local match from Jeffrey M. Weller, the owner of the subject property, in the amount of \$62,212.50 for completion of the flood hazard mitigation project described in this ordinance.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to fund the elevation of a private residential structure located at 13410 Eynon Drive, Jacksonville, Florida 32258, as approved by FDEM and FEMA in accordance with the HMGP (the "Project"), to mitigate the continued repetitive loss of the aforementioned flood-prone property. All activities associated with the Project shall be completed in strict compliance with federal, state and local rules and regulations. The term of the grant, and period of performance for the Project, begins upon the City and FDEM's execution of that certain Federally-Funded Subaward and Grant Agreement Number H0344 (the "Grant Agreement") and shall

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end on June 30, 2022. The Grant Agreement requires a 25% local match (\$62,212.50) for the Project which will be paid by the owner of the subject property, Jeffrey M. Weller, as set forth in that certain Hazard Mitigation Assistance Grant Agreement between the City and Jeffrey M. Weller (the "Owner's Agreement").

Approval and Authorization to Section 3. Execute Agreements. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver, for and on behalf of the City, the Grant Agreement and Owner's Agreement, and any respective extensions or amendments thereto as necessary and appropriate to effectuate the intent of this ordinance (collectively, the "Agreements"), substantially in the forms placed On File with the Office of Legislative Services.

Section 4. Oversight Department. The Jacksonville Fire and Rescue Department, Emergency Preparedness Division, shall oversee Project, including administration of the Agreements, as described herein.

Effective Date. This ordinance shall become Section 5. effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
