7 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$248,850.00
8 (\$186,637.50 FROM THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY
9 MANAGEMENT AGENCY THROUGH THE FLORIDA DIVISION
10 OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT ("FDEM") AND A 25%
11 LOCAL MATCH OF \$62,212.50 FROM JEFFREY M.
12 WELLER, THE OWNER OF THE SUBJECT PROPERTY)
13 UNDER THE HAZARD MITIGATION GRANT PROGRAM TO
14 FUND THE ELEVATION OF A PRIVATE RESIDENTIAL
15 STRUCTURE LOCATED AT 13410 EYNON DRIVE,
16 JACKSONVILLE, FLORIDA 32258, AS INITIATED BY
17 REVISED B.T. 21-018; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR
18 HIS DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY,
19 TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER, FOR AND ON BEHALF OF
20 THE CITY THAT CERTAIN FEDERALLY-FUNDED
21 SUBAWARD AND GRANT AGREEMENT NUMBER H0433
22 BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE (THE "CITY")
23 AND FDEM, AND THAT CERTAIN HAZARD MITIGATION
24 ASSISTANCE GRANT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY
25 AND JEFFREY M. WELLER; PROVIDING FOR CITY
26 OVERSIGHT BY THE JACKSONVILLE FIRE AND RESCUE
27 DEPARTMENT, EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS DIVISION;
28 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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30 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

1 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2020-2021 fiscal year,
2 within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the
3 indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to
4 the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

5 (Revised B.T. 21-018, attached hereto as **Revised Exhibit 1**, labeled
6 as "Revised Exhibit 1, Revised B.T. 21-018, January 4, 2021 -
7 NCSPHS" and incorporated herein by this reference)

12 (c) Explanation of Appropriation

13 The funding above represents a Hazard Mitigation Grant
14 Program ("HMGP") award in the amount of \$186,637.50 from
15 the Federal Emergency Management Agency ("FEMA") through
16 the State of Florida Division of Emergency Management
17 ("FDEM") plus a 25% local match from Jeffrey M. Weller,
18 the owner of the subject property, in the amount of
19 \$62,212.50 for completion of the flood hazard mitigation
20 project described in this ordinance.

21 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
22 Section 1 is to fund the elevation of a private residential
23 structure located at 13410 Eynon Drive, Jacksonville, Florida
24 32258, as approved by FDEM and FEMA in accordance with the HMGP
25 (the "Project"), to mitigate the continued repetitive loss of the
26 aforementioned flood-prone property. All activities associated
27 with the Project shall be completed in strict compliance with
28 federal, state and local rules and regulations. The term of the
29 grant, and period of performance for the Project, begins upon the
30 City and FDEM's execution of that certain Federally-Funded Subaward
31 and Grant Agreement Number H0344 (the "Grant Agreement") and shall

1 end on June 30, 2022. The Grant Agreement requires a 25% local
2 match (\$62,212.50) for the Project which will be paid by the owner
3 of the subject property, Jeffrey M. Weller, as set forth in that
4 certain Hazard Mitigation Assistance Grant Agreement between the
5 City and Jeffrey M. Weller (the "Owner's Agreement").

6 **Section 3. Approval and Authorization to Execute**
7 **Agreements.** There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or his
8 designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to
9 execute and deliver, for and on behalf of the City, the Grant
10 Agreement and Owner's Agreement, and any respective extensions or
11 amendments thereto as necessary and appropriate to effectuate the
12 intent of this ordinance (collectively, the "Agreements"), in
13 substantially in the forms placed **On File** with the Office of
14 Legislative Services.

15 **Section 4. Oversight Department.** The Jacksonville Fire
16 and Rescue Department, Emergency Preparedness Division, shall
17 oversee Project, including administration of the Agreements, as
18 described herein.

19 **Section 5. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become
20 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
21 without the Mayor's signature.
