5 ORDINANCE ABANDONING THE CONSOLIDATED AN DOWNTOWN DEVELOPMENT OF REGIONAL IMPACT (DRI) 6 7 PURSUANT TO SECTION 380.06, FLORIDA STATUTES; 8 ABANDONING RESOLUTION 92-392-489, AS AMENDED, WHICH APPROVED THE DEVELOPMENT ORDERS FOR THE 9 CONSOLIDATED DOWNTOWN DRI; FINDING THAT 10 ALL 11 CONDITIONS OF THE DEVELOPMENT ORDERS FOR THE CONSOLIDATED DOWNTOWN DRI HAVE BEEN MET, ARE NO 12 13 LONGER APPLICABLE, OR WILL CONTINUE ΤO ΒE IMPLEMENTED THROUGH THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE 14 15 COMPREHENSIVE PLAN AND LAND DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS; DIRECTING FILING OF A NOTICE OF 16 ABANDONMENT WITH THE CLERK OF THE CIRCUIT COURT 17 380.06(11), FLORIDA 18 PURSUANT ΤO SECTION STATUTES; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE. 19

WHEREAS, the Council adopted and approved the Consolidated Downtown Development of Regional Impact (DRI) Development Order by Resolution 92-392-489, and subsequently, has amended the Development Order by various Resolutions and Ordinances, as was required by Section 380.06, *Florida Statutes* (development orders); and

WHEREAS, Section 380.06, Florida Statutes, has been amended over time to remove DRI requirements and the Downtown Investment Authority, in collaboration with the Planning and Development Department, initiated the process and procedures to abandon the Consolidated Downtown DRI, and its associated development orders, 1 to simplify the regulatory procedures for development and 2 redevelopment in Downtown, enhance economic growth, and achieve the 3 City of Jacksonville's vision for Downtown; and

WHEREAS, the Planning and Development Department has submitted
recommendations concerning the abandonment of the Consolidated
Downtown DRI, and its associated development orders; and

7 WHEREAS, the Land Use and Zoning Committee has reviewed the 8 abandonment of the Consolidated Downtown DRI, and its associated 9 development orders, and made its recommendation to the Council; and

10 WHEREAS, a public hearing was properly noticed and held by the 11 Council pursuant to Section 380.06, *Florida Statutes*; and

WHEREAS, after such public hearing and in consideration of the recommendations made and submitted to the Council, the Council desires to abandon the Consolidated Downtown DRI, and its associated development orders; now, therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Consolidated Downtown 17 DRI Abandoned. The Consolidated Downtown DRI, and its associated development orders, 18 19 are hereby abandoned pursuant to Section 380.06(11), Florida Statutes. The Council finds that all conditions of Resolution 92-20 21 392-489, as amended, which approved the development orders for the 22 Consolidated Downtown DRI have been met, are no longer applicable, 23 or will continue to be implemented through the City of Jacksonville Comprehensive Plan and land development regulations, as described 24 25 in **Exhibit 1, attached hereto**. Pursuant to Section 380.06(11), 26 Florida Statutes, all development following abandonment shall be 27 fully consistent with the Comprehensive Plan and applicable zoning regulations in place at the time of such future development. 28

29 Section 2. Notice. Pursuant to Section 380.06(11), 30 Florida Statutes, the Office of General Counsel is directed to 31 prepare and file a notice of the abandonment approved herein with
