Bill Summary: This bill reappropriates \$200,000.00 from the Social Justice and Community Investment Special Committee Contingency to Neighborhoods Department - Municipal Code Compliance Division for a Neighborhood Blight Clean-Up Pilot Program in the Brentwood Neighborhood.

Background Information: The Neighborhood Blight and Clean–up Pilot Program is designed to create a successful road map with specific infrastructure investments and clean up assistance within the Brentwood neighborhood. The area has 50 active nuisance and boarded up cases, 16 unsafe structures, cases of graffiti, and additional code enforcement concerns. With the high amounts of identified blighted structures, the pilot program will reduce crime and increase the residents' quality of life.

Policy Impact Area: Blight, Neighborhood Clean up

Fiscal Impact: The appropriation of \$1,484,210.00, as initiated by B.T. 21-024.
