AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$50,000.00 FROM THE NORTHWEST JACKSONVILLE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT FUND - CONTINGENCY TO THE NORTHWEST JACKSONVILLE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT FUND - SUBSIDIES AND CONTRIBUTIONS TO FUND Α GRANT ΤО THE JACKSONVILLE TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY FOR THE "DOOR-TO-STORE PROGRAM" (THE "PROGRAM"), A COMPONENT OF THE FULL-SERVICE GROCERY STORE IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM ESTABLISHED UNDER ORDINANCE 2019-812-E, AS INITIATED BY B.T. APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY EXECUTE AND DELIVER THAT CERTAIN FUNDING AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND THE JACKSONVILLE TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY TO CONTINUE THE PROGRAM FOR AN ADDITIONAL ONE (1) YEAR TERM; PROVIDING FOR CITY OVERSIGHT AND PROGRAM ADMINISTRATION BY THE OFFICE OF ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT; PROVIDING FOR A REPORT TO TRANSPORTATION, ENERGY AND UTILITIES COMMITTEE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Appropriation. For the 2020-2021 fiscal year, Section 1. within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

(c) Explanation of Appropriation:

The funding above is a transfer of funds from the Northwest Jacksonville Economic Development Fund - Contingency to the Northwest Jacksonville Economic Development Fund - Subsidies and Contributions (the "Trust Fund") to fund a grant to the Jacksonville Transportation Authority (JTA) to enable the City to continue operation of the Program for an additional one (1) year term.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to fund the Program for an additional one (1) year term. The Program provides complimentary on-demand transportation services to local grocery stores for residents of the Northwest Jacksonville Economic Development Area (the "Area") and incentivizes the operation of new supermarkets and healthy food programs within the Area. JTA will retain excess grant funds appropriated by the City for the first year of the Program authorized under Ordinance 2019-812-E as additional funding to support the second year of the Program, up to a maximum carryover amount of \$25,000.00. Any grant funds in excess of \$25,000.00 remaining from the first year of the Program shall be returned to the City.

Section 3. Approval and authorization. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver, for and on behalf of the City, that certain Funding Agreement between the City of Jacksonville and the Jacksonville Transportation Authority,
