4 **ORDINANCE 2021-47**

5 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$310,974.00 FROM THE
6 FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY ("FEMA")
7 THROUGH THE STATE OF FLORIDA DIVISION OF
8 EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT ("FDEM") UNDER THE FLOOD
9 MITIGATION ASSISTANCE GRANT PROGRAM TO FUND THE
10 ACQUISITION OF PROPERTY LOCATED AT 6734
11 BAKERSFIELD DRIVE, JACKSONVILLE, FLORIDA 32210
12 (RE# 012147-0000) AND THE DEMOLITION OF THE
13 RESIDENTIAL STRUCTURE LOCATED THEREON, AS
14 INITIATED BY B.T. 21-027; AMENDING THE 2021-2025
15 FIVE-YEAR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN APPROVED BY
16 ORDINANCE 2020-505-E TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR THE
17 PROJECT ENTITLED "ACQUISITION AND DEMO OF A
18 FLOODPRONE PROPERTY - BAKERSFIELD DRIVE";
19 APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS
20 DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY, TO
21 EXECUTE AND DELIVER THAT CERTAIN FEDERALLY-
22 FUNDED SUBAWARD AND GRANT AGREEMENT NUMBER B0093
23 BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE (THE "CITY")
24 AND FDEM; PROVIDING FOR CITY OVERSIGHT BY THE
25 JACKSONVILLE FIRE AND RESCUE DEPARTMENT,
26 EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS DIVISION; PROVIDING AN
27 EFFECTIVE DATE.

29 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

30 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2020-2021 fiscal year,
31 within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated

9 (c) Explanation of Appropriation:

10 The funding above represents a Flood Mitigation Assistance
11 Grant Program ("FMAGP") award in the amount of \$310,974.00
12 from the Federal Emergency Management Agency through the
13 State of Florida Division of Emergency Management for
14 completion of the flood hazard mitigation project described
15 in this ordinance. No local match is required.

16 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
17 Section 1 is to fund the acquisition of that certain property
18 identified by the FEMA National Flood Insurance Program as a "Severe
19 Repetitive Loss Property", located at 6734 Bakersfield Drive,
20 Jacksonville, Florida 32210 (RE# 012147-0000) (the "Property"), and
21 to fund demolition of the private residential structure located
22 thereon, including removal of foundation slabs and any debris on the
23 Property, as approved by FDEM and FEMA in accordance with the FMAGP
24 (the "Project"). Upon completion of the Project, the land will become
25 subject to a perpetual open space conservation easement. All
26 activities associated with the Project shall be completed in strict
27 compliance with federal, state and local rules and regulations. The
28 term of the grant, and the period of performance for the Project,
29 shall begin upon the City and FDEM's execution of that certain
30 Federally-Funded Subaward and Grant Agreement Number B0093 (the
31 "Grant Agreement") and shall end on April 1, 2023.

1 **Section 3. Capital Improvement Plan Amendment.** Ordinance

2 2020-505-E, adopting the 2021-2025 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan
3 ("CIP") for the City and certain of its independent agencies, is
4 hereby amended to provide funding for the project entitled
5 "Acquisition and Demo of a Floodprone Property - Bakersfield Drive."
6 The Project is more fully described in the Project Information Sheet,
7 attached hereto as **Exhibit 2** and incorporated herein by this
8 reference. The City Council finds that the deferral of this amendment
9 to the CIP until the next annual budget and CIP review will be
10 detrimental to the best interests of the community because such
11 deferral will delay urgently-needed mitigation of this floodprone
12 property and the safe removal of residents from the immediate dangers
13 of flooding. The Property is located in an area that is subject to
14 persistent nuisance flooding and the Project will reduce future costs
15 to the county, state and federal agencies that provide evacuation and
16 rescue, emergency shelter, and debris removal services in the area.
17 Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), *Ordinance Code*, enactment of this
18 ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the City
19 Council members present at the meeting because of the CIP amendment
20 set forth in this section. This ordinance shall constitute an
21 amendment to Ordinance 2020-505-E. In all other respects, the Five-
22 Year Capital Improvement Plan approved by Ordinance 2020-505-E shall
23 remain unchanged and continue in full force and effect.

24 **Section 4. Approval and Authorization of Grant Agreement.**

25 There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and the
26 Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver,
27 for and on behalf of the City, the Grant Agreement and any respective
28 extensions or amendments thereto as necessary and appropriate to
29 effectuate the intent of this ordinance. A copy of the Grant
30 Agreement has been placed **On File** with the Office of Legislative
31 Services.
