5 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$74,993.00 IN FUND
6 BALANCE FROM THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION FUND
7 TO FUND THE DEVELOPMENT OF A WATER QUALITY
8 MODULE FOR INCLUSION IN A HYDRODYNAMIC MODELING
9 PROGRAM CREATED BY THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH
10 FLORIDA ("UNF"), AS INITIATED BY B.T. 21-028;
11 PROVIDING FOR CARRYOVER OF FUNDS THROUGH
12 SEPTEMBER 30, 2022; INVOKING THE EXCEPTION OF
13 SECTION 126.107(G) (EXEMPTIONS), CHAPTER 126
14 (PROCUREMENT CODE), *ORDINANCE CODE*, TO DIRECT
15 CONTRACT WITH THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH FLORIDA
16 FOR DEVELOPMENT OF THE WATER QUALITY MODULE;
17 APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS
18 DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY TO
19 EXECUTE AND DELIVER THAT CERTAIN
20 RESEARCH/ACADEMIC SERVICES AGREEMENT BETWEEN
21 THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND THE UNF BOARD OF
22 TRUSTEES; PROVIDING FOR CITY OVERSIGHT BY THE
23 NEIGHBORHOODS DEPARTMENT, ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY
24 DIVISION; REQUIRING A FINAL REPORT; PROVIDING AN
25 EFFECTIVE DATE.

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27 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

28 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2020-2021 fiscal year,
29 within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated
30 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)
31 listed in subsection (b):

7 (c) Explanation of Appropriation:

8 The appropriation above is appropriating fund balance from
9 the Environmental Protection Fund to fund the development
10 of a water quality module to be included in a hydrodynamic
11 modeling program created by the University of North Florida
12 (the "Project").

13 **Section 2. Carryover.** The funds appropriated in Section 1
14 of this ordinance shall not lapse but shall carryover into fiscal
15 year 2021-2022.

16 **Section 3. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
17 Section 1 is to provide funding to the University of North Florida
18 for the Project which shall be completed pursuant to the terms,
19 conditions and scope of services more particularly described in that
20 certain Research/Academic Services Agreement between the City of
21 Jacksonville and the UNF Board of Trustees, as approved and authorized
22 in Section 5 below. The Environmental Protection Board approved this
23 expenditure of Environmental Protection Fund dollars at its meeting
24 on December 16, 2019.

25 **Section 4. Invoking the exception pursuant to Section**
26 **126.107(g), Ordinance Code.** The City is hereby authorized to enter
27 into the Agreement authorized in Section 5 below. Pursuant to Section
28 126.107(g) (Exemptions), Part 1 (General Regulations), Chapter 126
29 (Procurement Code), *Ordinance Code*, such procurement is exempted from
30 competitive solicitation because the supplies or services are to be
31 provided by those specifically prescribed within authorizing

1 legislation that appropriates the same. With the exception of the
2 foregoing, all other provisions of Chapter 126, *Ordinance Code*, shall
3 remain in full force and effect.

4 **Section 5. Approval and Authorization of the Agreement.**

5 There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and the
6 Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized, to execute and deliver,
7 for and on behalf of the City, that certain University of North
8 Florida Research/Academic Services Agreement between the City of
9 Jacksonville and the University of North Florida Board of Trustees
10 (the "Agreement"), substantially in the form placed **On File** with the
11 Office of Legislative Services, and any respective extensions or
12 amendments thereto as necessary and appropriate to effectuate the
13 intent of this ordinance.

14 **Section 6. Oversight Department.** The Neighborhoods

15 Department, Environmental Quality Division, shall oversee the
16 Project.

17 **Section 7. Final Report.** A final report shall be

18 provided by UNF to the City's Environmental Protection Board at the
19 conclusion of the Project.

20 **Section 8. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become

21 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
22 without the Mayor's signature.
