pass-through funds distributed by Florida Housing Finance 1 2 Corporation to the City of Jacksonville pursuant to that 3 certain First Amendment to Agreement Number 049-2020 (Coronavirus Relief Fund (CRF) Subrecipient Agreement), in 4 substantially the form placed **On File** with the Office of 5 Legislative Services, for the continued provision of 6 7 housing-related assistance to eliqible households 8 experiencing hardships as a result of the COVID-19 9 pandemic. There is no local match for these funds. These 10 Coronavirus relief funds may be expended on eligible activities that occur between March 1, 2020 and January 11 15, 2021 and must be expended by no later than January 15, 12 2021. Any funds that are not expended by January 15, 2021, 13 will be returned to Florida Housing Finance Corporation 14 15 and in turn to the United States Department of the 16 Treasury.

17 Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to provide additional housing-related assistance to 18 19 eligible households that continue to experience hardships due to the 20 COVID-19 pandemic. Rental and mortgage assistance payments or 21 payments for emergency home repairs (and related counseling) for 22 persons experiencing COVID-19 related hardships that prevent them 23 from making these payments are eligible uses of these CARES Act pass-24 through dollars. The City is authorized to spend up to ten percent 25 (10%) of these Coronavirus relief funds for administrative costs.

Section 3. Oversight. The Housing and Community
Development Division of the Neighborhoods Department shall oversee
the administration and disbursement of these funds.

29 Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become 30 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective 31 without the Mayor's signature.
