6 **ORDINANCE 2020-758-E**

7 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$140,000 FROM THE
8 SOCIAL JUSTICE AND COMMUNITY INVESTMENT
9 SPECIAL COMMITTEE CONTINGENCY TO KIDS HOPE
10 ALLIANCE ("KHA") TO ALLOW KHA TO PROVIDE
11 FUNDING TO THE TEEN COURT PROGRAM; AUTHORIZING
12 KHA TO PROVIDE FUNDING IN THE AMOUNT OF
13 \$140,000 TO THE FOURTH JUDICIAL CIRCUIT COURT
14 OF FLORIDA FOR TEEN COURT TO PROVIDE FOR 2.5
15 CASE MANAGERS AND ADDITIONAL COUNSELING;
16 AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AND
17 CORPORATION SECRETARY, AND/OR THE CHIEF
18 EXECUTIVE OFFICER OF THE KIDS HOPE ALLIANCE TO
19 EXECUTE AND DELIVER A SERVICES CONTRACT WITH
20 THE FOURTH JUDICIAL CIRCUIT COURT OF FLORIDA
21 TO PROVIDE THE SERVICES SPECIFIED IN THIS
22 ORDINANCE; INVOKING THE EXCEPTION OF SECTION
23 126.107(G) (EXEMPTIONS), PART 1 (GENERAL
24 REGULATIONS), CHAPTER 126 (PROCUREMENT CODE),
25 *ORDINANCE CODE*, REGARDING THE SERVICES TO BE
26 PROVIDED BY THE FOURTH JUDICIAL CIRCUIT COURT
27 OF FLORIDA; WAIVING THE REQUIREMENTS OF
28 CHAPTER 77 (KIDS HOPE ALLIANCE), SECTION
29 77.111(A) (PROVIDER CONTRACTS), *ORDINANCE*
30 *CODE*, TO EXEMPT THE SERVICES TO BE PROVIDED BY

1 THE FOURTH JUDICIAL CIRCUIT COURT OF FLORIDA
2 FROM COMPETITIVE PROCUREMENT; PROVIDING FOR
3 OVERSIGHT BY THE KIDS HOPE ALLIANCE; PROVIDING
4 AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

6 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

7 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2020-2021 fiscal year,
8 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the
9 indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to
10 the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

12 incorporated herein by this reference)

17 (c) Explanation of Appropriation

18 The appropriation above provides \$140,000 in funding from
19 the Social Justice and Community Investment Special
20 Committee Contingency account to KHA to the Fourth
21 Judicial Circuit Court of Florida for provide funding to
22 Teen Court for 2.5 additional case managers and to
23 provide additional counseling.

24 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
25 Section 1 is to provide funding in the amount of \$140,000 to allow
26 KHA to provide funding to the Fourth Judicial Circuit Court of
27 Florida for Teen Court for 2.5 additional case managers and to
28 provide additional counseling. A description of the Teen Court
29 services and proposed budget is attached hereto as **Exhibit 2**.

30 **Section 3. Approval and authorization to execute.** The
31 Mayor, or his designee, the Corporation Secretary, and/or the Chief

1 Executive Officer ("CEO") of KHA are hereby authorized to execute
2 and deliver a contract with the Fourth Judicial Circuit Court of
3 Florida for the services specified in this ordinance, in
4 substantially the form attached hereto as **Exhibit 3** and
5 incorporated herein.

6 **Section 4. Invoking the exception to Section 126.107(g),**
7 **Ordinance Code.** KHA is hereby authorized to directly procure
8 the use of the professional services of the Fourth Judicial Circuit
9 Court of Florida, to provide services as more particularly
10 described in Section 2. Pursuant to Section 126.107(g)
11 (Exemptions), Part 1 (General Regulations), Chapter 126
12 (Procurement Code), *Ordinance Code*, such procurement is exempted
13 from competitive solicitation because the supplies or services are
14 to be provided by those specifically prescribed within authorizing
15 legislation that appropriates the same. With the exception of the
16 foregoing, all other provisions of Chapter 126, *Ordinance Code*,
17 shall remain in full force and effect.

18 **Section 5. Waiving the requirements of Chapter 77 (Kids**
19 **Hope Alliance), Section 77.111(a) (Provider Contracts), Ordinance**
20 **Code.** The City hereby waives the requirements of Chapter 77 (Kids
21 Hope Alliance), Section 77.111(a) (Provider Contracts), *Ordinance*
22 *Code*, with respect to the contract approved and authorized under
23 Section 3 of this Ordinance. Section 77.111(a) requires contracts
24 for children's services to be competitively procured by KHA via an
25 evaluated bid process. This waiver is needed because the Fourth
26 Judicial Circuit Court is the sole provider of the Duval County
27 Teen Court Program.

28 **Section 6. Oversight.** KHA will oversee the project and
29 services described in Section 2 above and will ensure compliance
30 with all other appropriate laws.

31 **Section 7. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become

1 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
2 without the Mayor's signature.
