18 WHEREAS, the Florida Inland Navigation District (FIND) 19 solicits grant applications from counties within its jurisdiction to 20 undertake waterways-related projects; and

21 WHEREAS, FIND grant applications must be accompanied by 22 legislation acknowledging a county's willingness to meet the matching 23 funding requirements; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Parks, Recreation and Community Services has compiled and recommends several grant projects for submission to FIND; and

WHEREAS, the Jacksonville Waterways Commission approved the recommended projects at its meeting on January 13, 2021; now, therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Recitals. The recitals above are true and correct and incorporated herein by reference.

3 Approved Projects. The 2021 FIND grant projects Section 2. recommended by the Department of Parks, Recreation and Community 4 Services listed on **Exhibit 1**, attached hereto and incorporated herein 5 by this reference (the "Projects"), are approved for submission to 6 7 the Florida Inland Navigation District for purposes of receiving such grants. The Projects are: Goodbys Creek Dredge (Council Districts 5 8 9 & 6); Castaway Island Dredge (CD 13); Riverview Park Boat Ramp (CD 8); Exchange Club Island Park Development (CD 1); and, Reed Island 10 11 Park Development (CD 2), as more particularly described in Exhibit 2, attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference. The 12 \$3,905,000.00, 13 five grant applications total \$1,775,000.00 reimbursable from FIND and \$2,130,000.00 from the City's match, 14 including internal engineering fees. 15

16 Section 3. Authorization. The Mayor, for and on behalf of 17 the City, is authorized to apply for Florida Inland Navigation 18 District grants for the Projects.

19 Section 4. Execution authorized. The Mayor, or his 20 designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to 21 execute and deliver, for and on behalf of the City, all grant 22 agreements for the Projects between the City and FIND, as well as any 23 and all documents related to such grants.

Section 5. Acknowledging willingness to match funding. The City of Jacksonville is willing to meet FIND's matching funding requirements as they relate to the Projects described in Exhibit 1. Copies of FIND's Attachment E-7 (Resolution for Assistance 2021 under the Florida Inland Navigation District Waterways Assistance Program) for each of the Projects are attached hereto as Exhibit 3 and
