7 AND CERTIFIED PUBLIC EXPENDITURES MEDICAID
8 PROGRAMS, ADMINISTERED BY THE STATE OF FLORIDA
9 AGENCY FOR HEALTH CARE ADMINISTRATION, TO FUND
10 THE ACQUISITION OF CERTAIN FIRE APPARATUS AND
11 REPLACEMENT CAPITAL EQUIPMENT AND TO FUND
12 ADDITIONAL PERSONNEL COSTS TO CONVERT ONE PART-
13 TIME FIRE/RESCUE EMS BILLING AND CODING
14 SPECIALIST POSITION TO A FULL-TIME EMS BILLING
15 AND CODING SPECIALIST POSITION WITHIN THE
16 JACKSONVILLE FIRE AND RESCUE DEPARTMENT, AS
17 INITIATED BY B.T. 21-036; AUTHORIZING SAID
18 POSITION, AS INITIATED BY R.C. 21-061; PROVIDING
19 AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
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21 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

22 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2020-2021 fiscal year,
23 within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated
24 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)
25 listed in subsection (b):

1 (c) Explanation of Appropriation:

2 The funding above represents a transfer of unbudgeted
3 revenue from the Fiscal Year 2019-2020 Managed Care Options
4 ("MCO") and Certified Public Expenditures ("CPE") Medicaid
5 Programs, administered by the State of Florida Agency for
6 Health Care Administration, to the Jacksonville Fire and
7 Rescue Department. No local match is required.

8 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
9 Section 1 is to fund the acquisition of certain fire apparatus and
10 replacement capital equipment lost in a ship fire, and additional
11 personnel costs for the conversion of one part-time EMS Billing and
12 Coding Specialist position to a full-time EMS Billing and Coding
13 Specialist position within the Jacksonville Fire and Rescue
14 Department to assist with the recapture of MCO/CPE funds and Medicare
15 ground ambulance data collection. Ongoing maintenance will be
16 required for the fire apparatus and equipment replacement items.

17 **Section 3. Authorization of Position.** There is hereby
18 authorized the position more fully described in R.C. 21-061, attached
19 hereto as **Exhibit 2** and incorporated herein by this reference.

20 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become
21 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
22 without the Mayor's signature.
