15 E TO PURCHASE AND INSTALL PERMANENT EMERGENCY
16 GENERATORS AT THE FOLLOWING LOCATIONS: HILLMAN
17 DRIVE, MYRTLE AVENUE, HILLY ROAD, BRADLEY ROAD,
18 JESSIE STREET, MCGRITS CREEK PARK/LEW BRANTLEY
19 AND SANDALWOOD CANAL; PROVIDING FOR CITY
20 OVERSIGHT BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS,
21 PUBLIC BUILDINGS DIVISION; PROVIDING AN
22 EFFECTIVE DATE.
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24 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

25 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2020-2021 fiscal year,
26 within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated
27 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)
28 listed in subsection (b):

3 **Section 3. Capital Improvement Plan Amendment.** Ordinance
4 2020-505-E, adopting the 2021-2025 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan
5 (the "CIP") for the City and certain of its independent agencies, is
6 hereby amended to provide funding for the Project, as more fully
7 described in the Project Information Sheet, attached hereto as **Exhibit**
8 **2** and incorporated herein by this reference. The City Council finds
9 that the deferral of this amendment of the CIP until the next annual
10 budget and CIP review will be detrimental to the best interests of
11 the community because such deferral will delay the acquisition and
12 installation of urgently-needed emergency generator systems at
13 multiple critical stormwater pump station locations to reduce and/or
14 mitigate the damage that might otherwise occur from severe weather
15 or other hazards. Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), *Ordinance Code*,
16 enactment of this ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-
17 thirds of the City Council members present at the meeting because of
18 the CIP amendment set forth in this section. This ordinance shall
19 constitute an amendment to Ordinance 2020-505-E. In all other
20 respects, the Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan approved by
21 Ordinance 2020-505-E shall remain unchanged and continue in full
22 force and effect.

23 **Section 4. Oversight Department.** The Department of Public
24 Works, Public Buildings Division, shall oversee the Project and
25 administration of the Grant Agreement described herein.

26 **Section 5. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become
27 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
28 without the Mayor's signature.
