ORDINANCE 2021-80

ORDINANCE REGARDING PARKING ΑN RATES FOR EMPLOYEES OF THE OFFICE OF THE PUBLIC DEFENDER FOR THE FOURTH JUDICIAL CIRCUIT; AMENDING SUB-PARAGRAPH (D) TO SECTION 122.202 (PARKING RATES AT MUNICIPAL PARKING LOTS), ORDINANCE CODE, TO EXTEND A MONTHLY DISCOUNT RATE TO EMPLOYEES OF THE OFFICE OF THE PUBLIC DEFENDER PARKING IN CITY OWNED PARKING FACILITIES FOR THE PERIOD MARCH 1 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2021; REQUESTING EMERGENCY PASSAGE UPON INTRODUCTION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Office of the Public Defender for the Fourth Judicial Circuit has been utilizing the Duval Street (Library) Parking Garage and has enjoyed discounted rates; and

WHEREAS, the Public Defender received a letter from the DIA, attached hereto as Exhibit 1, regarding the recently approved DIA Parking Rates for the Duval Street Parking Garage and Off-Street Parking and notification of an increase to the Public Defender's Office and its employees regarding same; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2020-568-E extended an afforded 50% discounted parking rate for City Employees who park in city garages and lots for an additional year; and

WHEREAS, although the Office of the Public Defender had been receiving a discounted rate for parking, neither the Public Defender's office nor the DIA can produce any documentation of the discounted rate; and

WHEREAS, employees of the Office of the Public Defender, although state employees, are public servants; and

WHEREAS, these government employees handle many criminal matters, including municipal ordinance violations and first appearance court (J1), and need to have secure parking; and

WHEREAS, the Council deliberated the same security consideration when building the crossover between the new Duval County Fourth Judicial Circuit Courthouse and the State Attorney's Office; now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Amending sub-paragraph (d) to Section 122.202 (Parking Rates at Municipal Parking Lots), Ordinance Code. Chapter 122 (Public Property), Part 2 (Municipal Parking Lots), Section 122.202 (Parking rates at municipal parking lots), Ordinance Code, is hereby amended to read as follows:

CHAPTER 122 PUBLIC PROPERTY.

* * *

PART 2. MUNICIPAL PARKING LOTS

* * *

Sec. 122.202 (Parking rates at municipal parking lots).

* *

(d) Effective October 1, 2014, all City employees (which term shall include all City of Jacksonville employees and employees of the Duval County Supervisor of Elections, Duval County Property Appraiser, Duval County Tax Collector, and Duval County Clerk of Court $_{7}$) and to employees of the Office of the Public Defender of the Fourth Judicial Circuit, who are monthly parkers at municipal owned parking facilities operated by the Office of Public Parking, shall be entitled to a reduced monthly parking rate, which shall be fifty percent (50%) of the established, monthly parking rate for the given facility for a seven (7) year duration and end as of through September

30, 2021. The Economic Development Officer Downtown Investment Authority shall file the employee rate schedule and any subsequent change to the employee rate schedule with the Council Secretary, and such rates shall become effective upon such filing unless and until the Council enacts an ordinance to the contrary.

Section 2. Requesting emergency passage upon introduction pursuant to Council Rules 4.901 Emergency. Emergency passage upon introduction of this legislation is requested. The nature of the emergency is that according to the letter from the DIA, the Public Defender's Office and its employees' parking rate increase will be effective March 1, 2021.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
