(c) Explanation of Appropriation

10 The funding above comprises incentive payments in the 11 amount of \$12,000 from CSX Transportation, Inc. (CSX) and 12 \$7,500 from the Florida Department of Transportation 13 (FDOT) for the closure of the East 59th Street railroad-14 highway grade crossing.

15 Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation 16 above is to provide incentive payments to the City from CSX and 17 FDOT for the permanent closure of the East 59th Street railroad-18 highway grade crossing.

Approval and authorization. There is hereby 19 Section 3. 20 approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation 21 Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver the Stipulation of Parties for the Closure of East 59th Street FDOT 22 Crossing Number 621069K Railroad-Highway Grade Crossing between and 23 24 among the City, CSX, and FDOT in substantially the form placed 25 Revised On File with the Office of Legislative Services. CSX has 26 filed an application with FDOT to close permanently the railroadhighway grade crossing located at East 59th Street. CSX and FDOT 27 28 will each provide incentive payments for the closure of the East 29 59th Street railroad-highway grade crossing. There is no current license agreement between City and CSX for this crossing and there 30 will not be one. 31

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Section 4. Oversight. The Department of Public Works
shall oversee the project described herein.

CIP Amendment. Ordinance 2020-505-E, being 3 Section 5. the 2021-2025 Five-Year Capital Improvement Program for the City 4 5 and certain of its independent agencies, is hereby amended to provide funding for the project entitled "Railroad Crossings." The 6 7 project is more fully described in the Project Information Sheet, attached hereto as Revised Exhibit 2, labeled as "Revised Exhibit 8 9 2, Revised CIP, January 19, 2021 - NCSPHS" and incorporated herein by this reference. The Council finds that the deferral of this 10 amendment of the CIP until the next annual budget and CIP review 11 will be detrimental to the best interests of the community because 12 such deferral will delay the desired closing of the railroad 13 crossing. Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), Ordinance Code, enactment 14 of this ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-thirds of 15 the Council members present at the meeting because of the CIP 16 amendment set forth in this section. This ordinance shall 17 constitute an amendment to Ordinance 2020-505-E. In all other 18 19 respects, the Five-Year Capital Improvement Program approved by Ordinance 2020-505-E shall continue in full force and effect. 20

Section 6. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
