Bill Summary: This bill approves the revisions and modifications of the proposed 2020B Series Text Amendment to the Future Land Use Element (FLUE) and Conservation/Coastal Management Element of the 2030 Comprehensive Plan with the procedures and requirements outlined in Chapter 650, Part 4, *Ordinance Code*.

Background Information: The revisions and modifications update Map L-4, Map C-1, the 100 Year Flood Hazard Area, and the Flood Zones Map. The amendment, adopted in Ordinance 2020-665-E, preserves and enhances present advantages, encourage the most appropriate use of land, water, and resources, consistent with the public interest, overcomes present deficiencies, and deals effectively with future problems that may result from the use and development of land within the City. The recommendations of the Planning and Development Department, Planning Commission, and Land Use and Zoning Committee were vetted and deemed necessary to transmit the amendment through the State's expedited review process.
