**Type of Action:** Appropriation; CIP amendment; designation of oversight agency

**Bill Summary:** The bill appropriates a \$1,037,130 grant from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) through the Florida Division of Emergency Management to fund the acquisition and installation of 7 permanent emergency generators at stormwater pump stations. It amends the 2021-25 Capital Improvement Plan to include a project for the installation of the generators and designates the Public Works Department as the oversight agency for the project.

**Background Information:** FEMA has agreed to reimburse the City up to \$1,037,130 to install emergency backup power generators at the following stormwater pump stations: Hillman Drive, Myrtle Avenue, Hilly Road, Bradley Road, Jessie Street, McGirts Creek Park/Lew Brantley, and Sandalwood Canal. The project must be completed by October 31, 2022.

**Policy Impact Area:** Stormwater control

**Fiscal Impact:** The bill appropriates a \$1,037,130 FEMA grant with no local match requirement.
