Dear President Hazouri and Members of City Council:
In accordance with Jacksonville Municipal Code, Sections 380.605 transmitted herewith is an application for a NonResidential Solid Waste Collection and Transportation Franchise application from GFL Solid Waste Southeast, LLC.

The Department of Public Works, Solid Waste Division has coordinated a review of the information submitted by the applicant, inspection of its facility and Jacksonville office location in addition to conducting telephone interviews with the applicant to discuss its existing and proposed operations and maintenance plan for expansion into Duval County and their business plan and marketing strategies to accomplish this expansion. The application was submitted with the appropriate fee of $\$ 1,500$.

Experience and Potential Significant Amount of Duval County Business -GFL Solid Waste Southeast, LLC is a wholly-owned indirect subsidiary of GFL Environmental, Inc., which is a publicly traded company organized in Ontario, Canada. The applicant is the fourth largest diversified environmental services company in North America. The applicant provides a comprehensive line of non-hazardous solid waste management, infrastructure and soil remediation and liquid waste management services through its platform of facilities throughout Canada and in 23 states in the US.

## Financial Resources

The applicant has acquired existing customer routes from Advanced Disposal Services and/or Waste Management, including branch location at 7580 Philips Highway in Jacksonville. GFL is publicly listed on the New York Stock Exchange and the Toronto Stock Exchange. GFL Solid Waste Southeast, LLC certifies that it has the financial resources to perform its duties and obligations as a franchise. The applicant's certificate of insurance has been reviewed by Risk Management staff and meets the specified insurance requirements.

## Disposal Methods, Ouantities, and Facilities

The applicant proposes to landfill all Class I franchised waste it collects at the City's Trail Ridge Landfill and estimates it will collect approximately 4,500 tons per month or 54,000 tons per year of solid waste.

The applicant's corporate headquarters are located at 3301 Benson Drive, Suite 601, Raleigh, NC 27609 with a local office at 7580 Philips Highway, Jacksonville, FL 32256 where their Duval County records can be examined.

## Evidence of Safety and Reliability and Sanitation

The applicant will begin operations with 13 solid waste trucks and a safety manual that will guide daily operations. The applicant has provided a summary of health and safety guidelines that create a safe operational culture which utilizes coaching, training and technology, to identify opportunities that influence performance results.

## Backeround Information

The applicant has certified that it has not been adjudicated in default on any govermment contracts or bids and that there are no unsatisfied final money judgments against it. Limited background checks have been completed by JSO's Interagency Special Investigator who found no records of public entity crimes, felony and/or misdemeanor charges.

Based upon the information received and reviewed, the Department recommends that the Council grant a franchise transfer for a Non-Residential Solid Waste Collection and Transportation Franchise to GFL Solid Waste Southeast, LLC based upon the following conditions:

1. execution of a franchise agreement as specified in Section $380.605(a)(6)$
2. submission of a payment bond, as specified in Section 380.608(f)
3. execution of an indemnification agreement, as specified in Section 380.608(h)

The Non-Residential Solid Waste Collection \& Transportation Franchise is to assure that solid waste is collected in a safe manner, it is necessary to limit such collection and grant such privilege to persons or companies who demonstrate that they are capable of doing so in a manner deemed by the City to be responsible, sound and consistent with the sanitation and environmental practices and policies established by the City.
B. The insurance requirements in Section $380.608(\mathrm{~g})$ of the ordinance code shall not be construed as imposing on the City of Jacksonville or the Department of Public Works, or any official or employee of the City, any liability or responsibility for injury to any person or property damaged by the franchisee.
C. Any changes to insurance policy must be communicated in writing to the City of Jacksonville's Risk Management Division thirty (30) days prior to taking effect.
D. The applicant agrees to abide by all applicable rules promulgated by the Department and in accordance with all City/County, State and Federal laws.
E. No franchisee under this section shall materially diminish or change the quantity or type of equipment used or methodology for collection, transportation or disposal of non-residential solid waste nor the location of disposal facilities described in this application, without first reporting such changes to the Department of Public Works, Solid Waste Division.
F. Dispose of all waste required to be disposed of in a Class I Landfill subject to the franchise at the Trail Ridge Landfill.
G. Any change of information included in the application and/or any operational changes shall be reported in the first monthly report submitted after the change occurs.
H. Any misrepresentation of information provided in the application shall be cause for suspension or revocation of the franchise.
I. The franchisee shall deliver to the Department of Public Works, Solid Waste Division, a certified true and correct monthly report of gross receipts generated during the previous month from accounts within the City on or before the last day of each month along with a check made payable to the City in the amount of $\mathbf{1 7 \%}$ of the franchisee's previous month's gross receipts. Gross receipts are defined as: "the entire amount of the fees (including the fair market value of bartered services) collected by the franchisee, for nonresidential solid waste collection, removal and disposal except (i) fees collected by the franchisee for the collection, transportation, sale or other disposition of exempt waste; (ii) income from equipment sales, maintenance and repair; and, (iii) state sales taxes and the franchise fee itself." By definition, the following fees are considered gross receipts: administrative, delivery, environmental, fuel, late, lease, paper invoice and rental fees. (Report Form will be provided by the Department).
J. The franchisee shall submit annual audited financial statements in accordance with $\mathbf{3 8 0 . 6 0 8}$ (b) (2) (i) by an independent certified public accountant licensed to do business in the state.
K. If the franchisee becomes insolvent or files a petition of voluntary or involuntary bankruptcy, its franchise shall terminate no later than the date of filing of the bankruptcy petition.
L. The applicant agrees to comply with all the terms and conditions of Part 6, Chapter 380 of the Jacksonville Municipal Code.

The contribution of Environmental Health and Safety in GFL is to create a safe operational culture based on leadership which utilizes coaching, training and technology, to identify opportunities that influence performance results. All dedicated to the concept that we will not harm the earth, hurt anyone or hit anything. Actively protecting life and property while stabilizing our place as an environmental steward and community leader.

## PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

Below are summaries of selected program highlights.
Established Training - Onboarding involves new hire and ongoing training, effectively assigned in both classroom format and on-line through Safety Sync and Flex programs. The online method is effective but adding real world verification and OJT improves reliability and retention.
Monthly leading indicators i.e., safety meetings, inspections and observational assessments: training involves daily launch, weekly tool box talks and monthly industry subjects. Flex uses handheld devices to generate and store all safety related data in Canadian while CAN (Computerized Access Network) is the primary driver of safety systems in the US. Committees are involved in inspections and investigation review. Driver observations are two per driver per quarter.
Statistics and Reports: GFL TRIR and LTI are tracked using standard dashboards. Monday to Date Incident counts are distributed weekly to ensure we react quickly to trends. Data is also distributed monthly in Board Level Reporting. Incident reporting can utilize mobile devices and transitioned to the Flex system as the investigations progress.

- Vehicle Monitoring: Currently utilizing Lytx event camera's in a third of the fleet, with Geotab, (no visual) providing GPS, and speed monitoring in another third. Upgrading to $3^{\text {rd }}$ 'generation DriveCam devices with additional viewing abilities and Machine Vision (cab recognition) A "Coaching" environment established.
- Bi-Weekly Calls and communications: GFL Safety Calls are bi-weekly between the safety teams and regions. Subjects are pre-selected and lead by Region VP's in coordination with EHS. A companywide call is held quarterly to openly discuss operational safety performance.
- Reviewing published illness and injury data from Bureau of Labor and Statistics (BLS), industry ratios have slightly improved throughout the sector. Although we've fallen short of our internal goal, the resulting TRIR is still below the levels of NAICS 56211 \& 562212 : waste collection -5.0 ; solid waste collection - 5.1 ; solid waste landfills - 5.3


## GFL EHS TEAM

EHS consist of eighteen (18) members with the core group (5) in corporate safety services. The safety services group works in a backroom capacity providing assistance in all universal applications. These include:

- Managing WSIB for 30+ GFL Solid Waste, Infrastructure \& Liquid Ontario;
- Monitoring policies/procedures, training \& evaluation processes for GFL's HSMS.
- Auditing Workwell and assist COR compliance, report findings to WSIB and IHSA
- Develop H\&S statistics and trending including costs for local, region and Shareholder Reports
- Standardize and develop and manage training, initiatives, policies/procedures, newsletters and/bulletins
- Supervise 3rd party qualification websites, i.e. ISN, Comply works, Browz, Contractor Check etc.
- Data entry on incident tracking systems; create PO's and complete payment on all safety related items
- Complete and coordinate COI requests for Solid Central, East and Michigan and Infrastructure


## SAFETY INITIATIVES

Initiatives don't change each year; we improve on failures and refresh the approach. Our primary initiative is to double down on daily countermeasures like seatbelts, observations and coaching; increase our use of technology; and maximizing our business partnerships through professional organizations, customer focus and industry peers. We continue to increase the amount and quality of our contact with employees. It's about people not statistics.

The cultural connection we build is based on daily communications and repairing ALL system failures.

- Review and Repair Cultural Disconnects - create greater opportunities for synergies between East, Central, West and US, as well as Ops and EHS, are a part of continuous improvement in an already strong safety structure. Utilizing corporate safety services and having standardized and consistent training, reporting procedures, policies, auditing and analysis, across our entire footprint, magnifies the message.
- Identify, Train and Manage by Exception - Increase the frequency of viewing data so we are more reactive (identifying trends in their early stages). Viewing on a scheduled basis; weekly, monthly and quarterly; raises awareness and a competitive spirit. It also gives us the opportunity to focus on the repeat or poorer performers early enough to reduce the risk.
- FLC Safety Training - front line supervision is essential to setting compliance with baseline countermeasures. Having open discussions on policy, intent, training methods and solicitation of feedback, improves decision-making. Making it in smaller more casual groups will hopefully bring some different insight.
- Executive Level Participation - We require a 24 hour lost time email notification; immediate calls on catastrophic cases; re-focus on DriveCam coaching effectiveness/Top 20 Riskiest Driver); spotlight the Monthly Mendoza Line and Quarterly Board Reporting.
- Early Injury Intervention - Area Director/Managers are notified immediately of all injuries to ensure proper classification of claims (new/aggravation/denial) and ultimately decrease recordable and lost times. Email notification will continue with the appropriate notifications within 2 minutes.
- Training - All written training, will continue to be housed in and upgraded to Flex, the data will be downloaded and placed in that system for retention. Safety meetings are scheduled for the same week/day each month. Additional training comes in the form of:
- ASTC - Monthly compliance training provided online including OSHA and DOT annual subjects.
- Coaching the Refuse Truck Driver Courses will be scheduled in each region at least once, per quarter.
- Auditing - The facility audit function will continue to utilize the tablet based program called iAuditor as well as the newly revised Flex audit program.
- Consolidation of EHS Services - Concorde has been enlisted to manage all aspects of Driver Compliance throughout the entire company.

Our never-ending mission is to operate efficiently through attention to details at all levels, while protecting our people, our equipment, our financial resources and our environment. The cycle of safety is infinite and part of everyday life. TRADITION. SAFETY.SERVICE. It's the center of who we are and what we do!
