7 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$14,384,362 OF CITY FUNDS AND \$12,500,000 OF JEA FUNDS TO PROVIDE 8 FUNDING FOR THE CHRISTOBEL NEIGHBORHOOD SEPTIC 9 TANK PHASE OUT PROJECT AS INITIATED BY B.T. 10 21-053; PURPOSE OF APPROPRIATION; PROVIDING A 11 CARRYOVER OF FUNDS FROM YEAR TO YEAR UNTIL 12 13 SUCH FUNDS ARE EXPENDED OR LAPSE ACCORDING TO THE AGREEMENT; AMENDING 2020-504-E, THE FY 14 15 2021 BUDGET ORDINANCE, TO REPLACE SCHEDULE B4, THE FY 2020-2021 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS PROJECTS 16 FUNDED VIA BORROWING, TO AUTHORIZE 17 THE BORROWING AND/OR THE ISSUANCE OF DEBT FOR THE 18 WATER/WASTEWATER SYSTEM FUND PROJECT; AMENDING 19 THE 2021-2025 FIVE-YEAR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT 20 PROGRAM APPROVED BY ORDINANCE 2020-505-E TO 21 ADD THE PROJECT ENTITLED "WATER/WASTEWATER 22 23 SYSTEM FUND"; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AND CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE 24 25 AND DELIVER A SECOND AMENDMENT ("AMENDMENT") 26 TO THE INTERAGENCY AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY 27 OF JACKSONVILLE AND JEA DATED MARCH 22, 2016; PROVIDING FOR CONSTRUCTION; PROVIDING AN 28 29 EFFECTIVE DATE.

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WHEREAS, the City and JEA have previously entered into that certain Interagency Agreement dated March 22, 2016, as authorized by 2015-764-E, as amended by that certain First Amendment to Interagency Agreement dated February 28, 2019, as authorized by 2018-747-E (collectively, the "Agreement"), to provide funding in part for City water and sewer projects as set forth in the Agreement and as codified in Chapter 751, Ordinance Code; and

8 WHEREAS, the City and JEA desire to amend the Agreement to 9 provide for an additional, one-time contribution in the 2020-2021 10 fiscal year by the JEA to the City in the amount of \$12,500,000, 11 with a one-time, City contribution in the 2020-2021 fiscal year in 12 the amount of \$14,384,362, to provide funding for the Christobel 13 neighborhood Septic Tank Phase-Out ("Project") as promulgated 14 pursuant to Chapter 751.106, Ordinance Code; now therefore

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BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

16 Section 1. Recitals. The recitals above are true and 17 correct and incorporated herein by reference.

18 Section 2. Appropriation. For the 2020-2021 fiscal year, 19 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the 20 indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to 21 the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

(a) 24 Appropriated from: See Revised B.T. 21-053 25 \$26,884,362 26 (b) Appropriated to: 27 See Revised B.T. 21-053 \$26,884,362 28 (C) Explanation of Appropriation 29 The appropriation authorizes the borrowing of \$14,384,362

30 from the City's Commercial Paper Facility and/or the 31 issuance of debt in the cumulative, maximum amount of

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\$14,384,362, and accepting the \$12,500,000 in funding from the JEA, and appropriates the funds to the designated area identified as the Christobel neighborhood as set forth on the Septic Tank Phase-Out Prioritization List as promulgated pursuant to Section 751.106, Ordinance Code.

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7 Section 3. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in 8 Section 2 is to contribute funding to the Project in the maximum, 9 cumulative amount of \$26,884,362, all as set forth on the Revised 10 Schedule B4 and Revised Schedule B4B, attached hereto as Exhibit 2 11 and Exhibit 3, respectively, and incorporated herein.

12 Section 4. Carryover. The funds appropriated herein shall 13 not lapse but shall carryover as appropriated from year to year 14 until such funds are expended or lapse according to the terms of 15 the Amendment.

Amending 2020-504-E, the FY 2020-2021 Budget 16 Section 5. 17 to replace Schedule в4 to allow for the Ordinance, "Water/Wastewater System Fund" Project. 2020-504-E, the FY 2020-18 19 2021 Budget Ordinance, is hereby amended to replace Schedule B4 20 Capital Improvement Projects Funded Via Borrowing to add the City 21 Project for the Christobel neighborhood Sewer Phase Out 22 improvements thereto. The Revised Schedule B4 is attached hereto as 23 Exhibit 2 and the Revised Schedule B4B is attached hereto as 24 Exhibit 3.

Section 6. 25 CIP Amendment. Ordinance 2020-505-E, being 26 the 2021-2025 Five-Year Capital Improvement Program for the City 27 and certain of its independent agencies ("CIP"), is hereby amended 28 add the project entitled "Water/Wastewater System Fund" to 29 ("Project"). The Project is more fully described in the Project 30 Information Sheet attached hereto as **Exhibit 4** and incorporated herein. The Council finds that the deferral of this amendment of 31

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the CIP until the next annual budget and CIP review will be 1 detrimental to the best interests of the community because such 2 3 deferral will result in delays in implementing the Christobel 4 neighborhood septic phase-out program. Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), Ordinance Code, enactment of this ordinance requires 5 approval by a two-thirds vote of the Council members present at the 6 7 meeting because of the CIP amendment set forth in this section. Except as amended herein, the Five-Year Capital Improvement Program 8 approved by Ordinance 2020-505-E shall continue in full force and 9 10 effect.

Section 7. Authorizing the Borrowing and Appropriation of 11 The City is hereby authorized to borrow under 12 Funds. its 13 Commercial Paper Program and/or issue fixed-rate debt in the cumulative, maximum amount of \$14,384,362 and such funds are hereby 14 15 appropriated to fund the Project. The authorization set forth in this Section is subject to the requirements and prerequisites of 16 17 the Commercial Paper Program and/or bond programs.

Section 8. Second to 18 Amendment Interagency Agreement 19 approved and execution authorized. The Second Amendment to the 20 March 22, 2016 Interagency Agreement by and between the City of 21 Jacksonville and JEA (the "Amendment") sets forth the collective 22 understanding and agreement of the City and JEA regarding an additional, one-time JEA contribution in 2020-2021 fiscal year of 23 \$12,500,000 from JEA to the City, and a one-time, additional City 24 25 Contribution of \$14,384,362 for the project authorized in the 26 Amendment, and continued cooperative efforts and responsibilities 27 regarding City sewer projects, is hereby approved. The Mayor, or 28 his designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized 29 to execute and deliver, for and on behalf of the City, the Amendment, in substantially the form as attached hereto as Exhibit 30 31 5 and incorporated herein by this reference.

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
