# 2021B Series Text Amendment City of Jacksonville 2030 Comprehensive Plan Capital Improvements Element

#### Policies 1.6.1

The City shall use a quantitative formula for purposes of assessing a landowner or developer's mobility fee for transportation impacts generated by a proposed development., where the The landowner or developer's mobility fee shall be calculated as set forth in Chapter 655, Part 5, Ordinance Code. equal:

- A. the cost per vehicle miles traveled per Mobility Zone multiplied by
- B. the average vehicle miles traveled per Development Area and then multiplied by the quantity
- C. development daily vehicle trips minus any trip reductions assessed to the development. Mobility fee credits shall be calculated as set forth in the Ordinance Code and will be applied to a landowner or developer's mobility fee as a reduction.

Landowner or Developer's Mobility Fee = (A x B x (C - Trip Reduction)) - Mobility Fee Credits

#### 1.6.2

The City shall use the most recent edition of the Institute of Transportation Engineer's (ITE) publication entitled *Trip Generation* to calculate the value of daily trips in the formula found in Policy 1.6.1. The City may collect the necessary data to create its own trip generation rates if the ITE manual is not reflective of local conditions.

# **ORDINANCE 2021-039**

Ordinance 2021-039 is an amendment to the Capital Improvements Element (CIE) of the 2030 Comprehensive Plan. This amendment is intended to remove specific calculations from the Comprehensive Plan regarding the Mobility Fee calculation and instead reflect all formulas and technical items within the Ordinance Code. The formula removed from Policy 1.6.1 of the Capital Improvement Element will now appear in Chapter 655, Part 5 of the Ordinance Code, specifically Sec. 655.503(e) (Mobility Fee Calculation).

The Planning and Development Department recommends **APPROVAL** of the text and map amendment in the attached **EXHIBIT 1** submitted as **Ordinance 2021-039**.

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE PROPOSED 2021B SERIES AMENDMENT TO THE CAPITAL **IMPROVEMENTS** ELEMENT OF THE 2030 COMPREHENSIVE PLAN OF THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE, TO REMOVE THE MOBILITY FEE CALCULATION FROM THE 2030 COMPREHENSIVE PLAN AND REFERENCE THE MOBILITY FEE CALCULATION IN THE ORDINANCE CODE, FOR TRANSMITTAL TO THE STATE OF FLORIDA'S VARIOUS AGENCIES FOR REVIEW; PROVIDING A DISCLAIMER THAT THE AMENDMENT TRANSMITTED HEREIN SHALL NOT BE CONSTRUED AS AN EXEMPTION FROM ANY OTHER APPLICABLE LAWS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Planning and Development Department has initiated certain revisions and modifications to the text of the 2030 Comprehensive Plan in accordance with the procedures and requirements set forth in Chapter 650, Part 4, Ordinance Code, to remove the mobility fee calculation from the 2030 Comprehensive Plan and reference the mobility fee calculation in the Ordinance Code, which are more particularly set forth in Exhibit 1, attached hereto, dated December 14, 2020, and incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, the Jacksonville Planning Commission, as the Local Planning Agency, held a public hearing on this proposed Amendment to the 2030 Comprehensive Plan, with due public notice having been provided, and reviewed and considered all comments received during the public hearing, and made a recommendation to the City Council;

WHEREAS, the Land Use and Zoning (LUZ) Committee held a public hearing on this proposed Amendment pursuant to Chapter 650, Part 4, Ordinance Code, and having considered all written and oral comments received during the public hearing, has made its recommendation to the Council; and

WHEREAS, the City Council held a public hearing on this proposed Amendment with public notice having been provided, pursuant to Section 163.3184(3), Florida Statutes, and Chapter 650, Part 4, Ordinance Code, and having considered all written and oral comments received during the public hearing, the recommendations of the Planning and Development Department, the Planning Commission and Committee, desires to transmit this proposed Amendment through the State's expedited state review process to the Florida Department of Economic Opportunity, as the State Land Planning Agency, the Northeast Florida Regional Council, the Florida Department of Transportation, the St. Johns River Water Management District, the Florida Department of Environmental Protection, the Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission, the Department of State's Bureau of Historic Preservation, the Florida Department of Education, and the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Affairs; now, therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council for the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Approval of Amendment for Transmittal Purposes. The Council hereby approves the proposed 2021B Series Text Amendment to the Capital Improvements Element of the 2030 Comprehensive Plan, as set forth in Exhibit 1, attached hereto, dated December 14, 2020, for transmittal to Florida's various required State Agencies for review.

Section 2. Disclaimer. The transmittal approved herein shall <u>not</u> be construed as an exemption from any other applicable local, state, or federal laws, regulations, requirements, permits or approvals. All other applicable local, state or federal permits or

approvals shall be obtained before commencement of the development or use, and transmittal is based upon acknowledgement, representation and confirmation made by the applicant(s), owner(s), developer(s) and/or any authorized agent(s) or designee(s) that the subject business, development and/or use will be operated in strict compliance with all laws. Transmittal does **not** approve, promote or condone any practice or act that is prohibited or restricted by any federal, state or local laws.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon the signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
