7 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$310,974.00 FROM EMERGENCY 8 THE FEDERAL MANAGEMENT AGENCY ("FEMA") THROUGH THE STATE OF FLORIDA DIVISION 9 EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT ("FDEM") UNDER THE 10 OF FLOOD MITIGATION ASSISTANCE GRANT PROGRAM TO 11 FUND THE ACQUISITION OF PROPERTY LOCATED AT 12 13 6734 BAKERSFIELD DRIVE, JACKSONVILLE, FLORIDA 32210 (RE# 012147-0000) AND THE DEMOLITION OF 14 15 THE RESIDENTIAL STRUCTURE LOCATED THEREON, AS 16 INITIATED BY B.T. 21-027; AMENDING THE 2021-17 2025 FIVE-YEAR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN 18 APPROVED BY ORDINANCE 2020-505-E TO PROVIDE 19 FUNDING FOR THE PROJECT ENTITLED "ACQUISITION 20 OF AND DEMO А FLOODPRONE PROPERTY 21 BAKERSFIELD DRIVE"; APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING 22 THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AND THE 23 CORPORATION SECRETARY, TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER 24 THAT CERTAIN FEDERALLY-FUNDED SUBAWARD AND 25 GRANT AGREEMENT NUMBER B0093 BETWEEN THE CITY 26 OF JACKSONVILLE (THE "CITY") AND FDEM; 27 PROVIDING FOR CITY OVERSIGHT ΒY THE 28 JACKSONVILLE FIRE AND RESCUE DEPARTMENT, 29 EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS DIVISION; PROVIDING AN 30 EFFECTIVE DATE.

1 2 BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville: 3 Appropriation. For the 2020-2021 fiscal year, Section 1. within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the 4 indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to 5 the account(s) listed in subsection (b): 6 7 (B.T. 21-027, attached hereto as **Exhibit 1** and incorporated herein by this reference) 8 9 (a) Appropriated from: 10 See B.T. 21-027 \$310,974.00 11 (b) Appropriated to: See B.T. 21-027 12 \$310,974,00 (c) Explanation of Appropriation: 13 The funding above represents a Flood Mitigation 14 Assistance Grant Program ("FMAGP") award in the amount of 15 \$310,974.00 from the Federal Emergency Management Agency 16 17 through the State of Florida Division of Emergency Management for completion of the flood hazard mitigation 18 project described in this ordinance. No local match is 19

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required.

21 Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in 22 Section 1 is to fund the acquisition of that certain property 23 identified by the FEMA National Flood Insurance Program as a "Severe Repetitive Loss Property", located at 6734 Bakersfield 24 25 Jacksonville, Florida 32210 (RE# 012147-0000) Drive, (the 26 "Property"), and to fund demolition of the private residential 27 structure located thereon, including removal of foundation slabs 28 and any debris on the Property, as approved by FDEM and FEMA in accordance with the FMAGP (the "Project"). Upon completion of the 29 30 Project, the land will become subject to a perpetual open space 31 conservation easement. All activities associated with the Project

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1 shall be completed in strict compliance with federal, state and 2 local rules and regulations. The term of the grant, and the period 3 of performance for the Project, shall begin upon the City and 4 FDEM's execution of that certain Federally-Funded Subaward and 5 Grant Agreement Number B0093 (the "Grant Agreement") and shall end 6 on April 1, 2023.

7 Section 3. Capital Improvement Plan Amendment. Ordinance 2020-505-E, adopting the 2021-2025 Five-Year Capital Improvement 8 9 Plan ("CIP") for the City and certain of its independent agencies, 10 is hereby amended to provide funding for the project entitled "Acquisition and Demo of a Floodprone Property - Bakersfield 11 The Project is more fully described in the Project 12 Drive." Information Sheet, attached hereto as Revised Exhibit 2, labeled as 13 "Revised Exhibit 2, Revised CIP, February 16, 2021 - NCSPHS" and 14 15 incorporated herein by this reference. The City Council finds that the deferral of this amendment to the CIP until the next annual 16 17 budget and CIP review will be detrimental to the best interests of the community because such deferral will delay urgently-needed 18 19 mitigation of this floodprone property and the safe removal of 20 residents from the immediate dangers of flooding. The Property is 21 located in an area that is subject to persistent nuisance flooding 22 and the Project will reduce future costs to the county, state and 23 federal agencies that provide evacuation and rescue, emergency 24 shelter, and debris removal services in the area. Pursuant to 25 Section 122.605(c), Ordinance Code, enactment of this ordinance 26 requires the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the City Council 27 members present at the meeting because of the CIP amendment set 28 forth in this section. This ordinance shall constitute an 29 amendment to Ordinance 2020-505-E. In all other respects, the Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan approved by Ordinance 2020-505-E 30 shall remain unchanged and continue in full force and effect. 31

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Approval and Authorization of Grant Agreement. 1 Section 4. 2 There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver, 3 for and on behalf of the City, the Grant Agreement and any 4 respective extensions or amendments thereto as necessary and 5 appropriate to effectuate the intent of this ordinance. A copy of 6 7 the Grant Agreement has been placed **On File** with the Office of Legislative Services. 8

9 Section 5. Oversight Department. The Jacksonville Fire 10 and Rescue Department, Emergency Preparedness Division, shall 11 oversee the Project and administration of the Grant Agreement 12 described herein.

Section 6. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
