7 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$162,865.00 IN
8 GRANT FUNDS FROM THE OFFICE OF JUSTICE
9 PROGRAMS, U.S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE FOR
10 FISCAL YEAR 2020-2021, AND APPROPRIATING
11 \$67,040.00 FROM THE KIDS HOPE ALLIANCE TO
12 COVER THE ADDITIONAL COSTS FOR THE FIRST YEAR
13 OF THE PROGRAM, TO FUND A COMPREHENSIVE ANTI-
14 GANG PROGRAM FOR YOUTH KNOWN AS "PROJECT
15 INSPIRE" AND TO FUND A CONTRACT MANAGER
16 POSITION FOR OVERSIGHT OF THIS GRANT PROGRAM
17 AND THE DIRECT SERVICE PROVIDER, AS INITIATED
18 BY B.T. 21-034; AMENDING SCHEDULE M TO
19 ORDINANCE 2020-511-E; AUTHORIZING SAID
20 CONTRACT MANAGER POSITION, AS INITIATED BY
21 R.C. 21-058; INVOKING THE EXCEPTION TO SECTION
22 126.107(G), *ORDINANCE CODE*, WITH RESPECT TO
23 SERVICES TO BE PROVIDED BY MANAGED ACCESS TO
24 CHILD HEALTH, INC.; APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING
25 THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AND THE
26 CORPORATION SECRETARY, AND/OR THE CHIEF
27 EXECUTIVE OFFICER OF THE KIDS HOPE ALLIANCE TO
28 EXECUTE AND DELIVER A CONTRACT WITH MANAGED
29 ACCESS TO CHILD HEALTH, INC.; WAIVING THE
30 REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 77.111(A) (PROVIDER

CONTRACTS), CHAPTER 77 (KIDS HOPE ALLIANCE),
ORDINANCE CODE, TO EXEMPT THE SERVICES TO BE
PROVIDED BY MANAGED ACCESS TO CHILD HEALTH,
INC. FROM COMPETITIVE PROCUREMENT; PROVIDING
FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE KIDS HOPE ALLIANCE;
PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2020-2021 fiscal year,
within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the
indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to
the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

(c) Explanation of Appropriation:

The funding above includes \$162,865.00 in grant funds
from the Office of Justice Programs, U.S. Department of
Justice, with an additional appropriation of \$67,040.00
from the Kids Hope Alliance ("KHA") to cover the
additional costs for the first year of the program.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in
Section 1 is to fund the first year of a comprehensive anti-gang
program for youth known as "Project INSPIRE" (Identifying Needs and
Supports to Partner, Intervene, Reengage and Educate youth) (the
"Program") for the period beginning October 1, 2020 through
September 30, 2021, with the overall term of the grant beginning
October 1, 2020 and ending September 30, 2023. A copy of the

1 Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs Juvenile Justice
2 and Delinquency Prevention Grant Award (Award Number 2020-MU-MU-
3 0047) has been placed **On File** with the Office of Legislative
4 Services. A copy of the budget schedule reflecting the intended
5 sources and uses of funds is attached hereto as **Exhibit 3**.

6 **Section 3. Amending Schedule M to Ordinance 2020-511-**
7 **E.** There is hereby amended for the fiscal year 2020-2021 budget
8 for the Kids Hope Alliance by substituting in the place of Schedule
9 M, approved by Ordinance 2020-511-E, the Revised Schedule M,
10 attached hereto as **Exhibit 4** and incorporated herein by this
11 reference. The Revised Schedule M will reflect additional transfers
12 and funds appropriated herein.

13 **Section 4. Authorization of Position.** There is hereby
14 authorized the contract manager position more fully described in
15 R.C. 21-058, attached hereto as **Exhibit 2** and incorporated herein
16 by this reference.

17 **Section 5. Invoking the exception to Section 126.107(g),**
18 **Ordinance Code.** KHA is hereby authorized to procure services
19 from Managed Access to Child Health, Inc. as necessary to comply
20 with grant requirements in connection with the Program authorized
21 in Section 1 above. Pursuant to Section 126.107(g) (Exemptions),
22 Part 1 (General Regulations), Chapter 126 (Procurement Code),
23 *Ordinance Code*, such services are exempted from competitive
24 solicitation because the services to be provided are being approved
25 via authorizing legislation pursuant to this ordinance.

26 **Section 6. Approval and Authorization.** The Mayor, or his
27 designee, and the Corporation Secretary, and/or the Chief Executive
28 Officer of KHA are hereby authorized to execute and deliver a
29 contract between KHA and Managed Access to Child Health, Inc. as is
30 necessary to comply with grant requirements in connection with the
31 Program authorized in Section 1.

1 **Section 7. Waiver of the provisions in Chapter 77 (Kids**
2 **Hope Alliance), Section 77.111(a) (Provider Contracts).** The City
3 hereby waives the provisions in Chapter 77 (Kids Hope Alliance),
4 Section 77.111(a) (Provider Contracts) with respect to the contract
5 with Managed Access to Child Health, Inc. approved and authorized
6 in Section 5 of this ordinance. Section 77.111(a) requires
7 contracts for children's services provided by third parties to be
8 competitively procured by KHA via an evaluated bid process. This
9 waiver is needed in order to allow KHA to meet grant requirements
10 by directly contracting with Managed Access to Child Health, Inc.
11 to provide Program services which was included in the approved
12 grant application.

13 **Section 8. Oversight Department.** The Kids Hope Alliance
14 shall oversee administration of the grant and the Program.

15 **Section 9. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become
16 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
17 without the Mayor's signature.
