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**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

22 Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2020-2021 fiscal year, 23 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the 24 indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to 25 the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

(c) Explanation of Appropriation:

The funding above is an appropriation of additional Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act pass-through funds distributed by Florida Housing Finance Corporation to the City of Jacksonville pursuant to that certain First Amendment to Agreement Number 049-2020 (Coronavirus Relief Fund (CRF) Subrecipient Agreement), which was approved by Ordinance 2020-555-E, in substantially the form placed **On File** with the Office of Legislative Services, for the continued provision of housing-related assistance to eligible households experiencing hardships as a result of the COVID-19 There is no local match for these funds. pandemic. These Coronavirus relief funds may be expended on eligible activities that occur between March 1, 2020 and January 15, 2021 and must be expended by no later than January 15, 2021. Any funds that are not expended by January 15, 2021, will be returned to Florida Housing Finance Corporation and in turn to the United States Department of the Treasury.

23 Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 2. Section 1 is to provide additional housing-related assistance to 24 25 eligible households that continue to experience hardships due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Rental and mortgage assistance payments or 26 27 payments for emergency home repairs (and related counseling) for 28 persons experiencing COVID-19 related hardships that prevent them 29 from making these payments are eligible uses of these CARES Act 30 pass-through dollars. The City is authorized to spend up to ten percent (10%) of these Coronavirus relief funds for administrative 31

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1 costs.
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2 Section 3. Oversight. The Housing and Community 3 Development Division of the Neighborhoods Department shall oversee 4 the administration and disbursement of these funds.

5 Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become 6 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective 7 without the Mayor's signature.
