Ordinance Code. The City is hereby authorized to directly procure the use of the professional services of All Things Diverse, LLC, to provide services as more particularly described in Section 2. Pursuant to Section 126.107(g) (Exemptions), Part 1 (General Regulations), Chapter 126 (Procurement Code), Ordinance Code, such procurement is exempted from competitive solicitation because the supplies or services are to be provided by those specifically prescribed within authorizing legislation that appropriates the same. With the exception of the foregoing, all other provisions of Chapter 126, Ordinance Code, shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 5. Waiving Section 110.112, Ordinance Code. Section 110.112 (Advance of City funds; prohibition against), Part 1 (The City Treasury), Chapter 110 (City Treasury), Ordinance Code, is hereby waived to allow for a partial advance payment as described in the Agreement.

Section 6. Oversight. The Council Secretary will oversee the Agreement described in Section 3 above and to ensure compliance with all other appropriate laws.

Section 7. Reverter. Any unused funds shall revert to the account of origin.

Section 8. Requesting One Cycle Emergency Passage Pursuant to Council Rule 4.901 Emergency. One cycle emergency passage of this legislation is requested. The nature of the emergency is that the "Safer Together" Series of Workshops have commenced and the workshops need to be completed by June 30, 2021.

Section 9. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
