(c) Explanation of Appropriation

The funds above are from Debt Management Fund Loan Proceeds for the design services for the renovation of an existing building for a new senior center at 4035 Grant Road.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to provide funds for the design services for the renovation of an unoccupied existing health clinic at 4035 Grant Road to become the Pine Forest Senior Center.

Section 3. CIP Amendment. Ordinance 2020-505-E, being the 2021-2025 Five-Year Capital Improvement Program for the City and certain of its independent agencies, is hereby amended to reduce the funding for the project entitled "San Jose Blvd - New" and provide funding for the project entitled "Pine Forest Senior Center." The projects are more fully described in the Project Information Sheet, attached hereto as Revised Exhibit 2, labeled as "Revised Exhibit 2, Revised CIP, February 16, 2021 - NCSPHS" and incorporated herein by this reference. The Council finds that the deferral of this amendment of the CIP until the next annual budget and CIP review will be detrimental to the best interests of the community because such deferral will result in the unnecessary delay of the design of the new senior center. Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), Ordinance Code, enactment of this ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the Council members present at the meeting because of the CIP amendment set forth in this section. This ordinance shall constitute an amendment to Ordinance 2020-505-E. In all other respects, the Five-Year Capital Improvement Program approved by Ordinance 2020-505-E shall continue in full force and effect.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become

effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
