Bill Summary: This bill confirms the Mayor's appointment of Heather Terrill as a member of the Art in Public Places Committee, replacing Lea M. Mahan, serving as a lay citizen representing Planning District #3, for a first full term ending December 31, 2023.

Background Information: The Art in Public Places Committee is established pursuant to Chapter 126, Ordinance Code, and charged to choose art which is compatible with and which will enhance the architecture and general environment of the City; responsible for receiving, reviewing and acting on the recommendations of the Art Selection Panels; seek to ensure that at least 15% of the artists selected for purchase or commission are resident(s) in the Greater Jacksonville area (Duval, St. Johns, Nassau, Clay and Baker Counties); and also encourage the selection of regional artists e.g. Florida and the Southeastern United States.

Section 126.903, Ordinance Code, provides that the eleven members of the committee are appointed by the Mayor, with five of the members representing the community at large, each residing within a different planning district.

Ms. Terrill works as the J Institute Program Manager at the Jewish Community Alliance. Previously she worked as a Museum Educator at MOCA Jacksonville. Ms. Terrill has a Bachelor of Arts from the University of North Florida. Ms. Terrill resides in Council District #5.
