7 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$168,375.00 FROM
8 DEBT MANAGEMENT FUND LOAN PROCEEDS TO PROVIDE
9 FUNDING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION, CONTINGENCY, AND
10 PERSONNEL COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE REPAIR AND
11 UPGRADE OF BRIDGE 724085 ON ORCHARD STREET, AS
12 INITIATED BY B.T. 20-086; AMENDING THE 2020-2024
13 FIVE-YEAR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM APPROVED
14 BY ORDINANCE 2019-505-E TO REDUCE FUNDING FOR
15 THE PROJECT ENTITLED "COUNTYWIDE INTERSECTION
16 IMP, BRGE-BRIDGES" AND PROVIDE FUNDING FOR THE
17 PROJECT ENTITLED "ORCHARD STREET BRIDGE
18 UPGRADES"; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
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20 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

21 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2019-2020 fiscal year,
22 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated
23 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)
24 listed in subsection (b):

31 (c) Explanation of Appropriation

1 The funding above is from Debt Management Fund Loan
2 Proceeds for the construction, contingency, and personnel
3 costs associated with the repair and upgrade of Bridge
4 724085 on Orchard Street.

5 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
6 Section 1 is to provide funding to upgrade to current Florida
7 Department of Transportation (FDOT) standards the guardrails on
8 Bridge 724085 on Orchard Street in order to provide the driving public
9 with traffic railing that will better prevent errant vehicles from
10 breaking through the railing and crashing into the creek. The asphalt
11 at both approaches to the bridge is damaged and needs to be repaired.
12 The repair items associated with this project constitute safety
13 upgrades and major maintenance to the bridge guardrail and pedestrian
14 barriers.

15 **Section 3. CIP Amendment.** Ordinance 2019-505-E, being the
16 2020-2024 Five-Year Capital Improvement Program for the City and
17 certain of its independent agencies, is hereby amended to reduce
18 funding for the project entitled "Countywide Intersection IMP, Brge-
19 Bridges" and provide funding for the project entitled "Orchard Street
20 Bridge Upgrades." The projects are more fully described in the Project
21 Information Sheets, attached hereto as **Revised Exhibit 2**, labeled as
22 "Revised Exhibit 2, Revised CIP, August 3, 2020 - NCSPHS" and
23 incorporated herein by this reference. The Council finds that the
24 deferral of this amendment of the CIP until the next annual budget
25 and CIP review will be detrimental to the best interests of the
26 community because such deferral will result in unnecessary delay in
27 repairing critical transportation infrastructure. Pursuant to Section
28 122.605(c), *Ordinance Code*, enactment of this ordinance requires the
29 affirmative vote of two-thirds of the Council members present at the
30 meeting because of the CIP amendment set forth in this section. This
31 ordinance shall constitute an amendment to Ordinance 2018-505-E. In

1 all other respects, the Five-Year Capital Improvement Program
2 approved by Ordinance 2018-505-E shall continue in full force and
3 effect.

4 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become
5 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
6 without the Mayor's signature.
