Gold Star Families shall be exempt from park admission fees as (C) described in Section 123.102, Ordinance Code. A Gold Star Family is the immediate family member(s) of a fallen service member who died while serving in a time of conflict. The Military and Veterans Affairs Department shall administer a program whereby a Gold Star Family must apply annually for the waiver of park admission fees to various parks (including the annual passes, where applicable). Upon the completion of the application and verification by of the Military and Veterans Affairs Department, the Parks, Recreation and Community Services Department will issue an annual pass for admission to all City parks to the Gold Star Family, which may be renewed annually subject to the administrative process created by the Military and Veterans Affairs Department in coordination with the Parks, Recreation and Community Services Department.

Section 2. Effective. This ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
