AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$475,000.00 IN FUNDS (A TRANSFER OF \$131,178 FROM FAIR SHARE SECTOR 4.2 FUNDS AND \$343,822 FROM SPECIAL EVENTS - FLORIDA GEORGIA GAME CONTINGENCY) TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR THE INSTALLATION OF A SIDEWALK ON COLLINS ROAD FROM PINEVERDE TO MATERA AVE (COLLINS ROAD SIDEWALK PROJECT); AMENDING THE 2021-2025 FIVE-YEAR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM APPROVED BY ORDINANCE 2020-505-E TO REDUCE FUNDING FOR THE PROJECT ENTITLED "YACHT CLUB ROAD - NEW SIDEWALK" AND PROVIDE FUNDING FOR THE PROJECT ENTITLED "COLLINS ROAD - NEW SIDEWALK"; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2020-2021 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

(c) Explanation of Appropriation

The appropriation above is an appropriation of \$475,000

(\$131,178 of the funds above are from the Fair Share Sector 4.20 Funds and \$343,822 are from Special Events - Florida Georgia Game Contingency) for the installation of a sidewalk on Collins Road from Pineverde Lane to Matera Avenue.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to provide funds for the design and construction of approximately 1.2 miles of new sidewalk along Collins Road from Pineverde Lane to Matera Avenue, to be known as the Collins Road Sidewalk Project.

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Section 3. CIP Amendment. Ordinance 2020-505-E, being the 2021-2025 Five-Year Capital Improvement Program for the City and certain of its independent agencies, is hereby amended to reduce the funding for the project entitled "Yacht Club Road - New Sidewalk" and provide funding for the project entitled "Collins Road Sidewalk - New Sidewalk." The projects are more fully described in the Project Information Sheets, attached hereto as Exhibit 2 and incorporated herein by this reference. The Council finds that the deferral of this amendment of the CIP until the next annual budget and CIP review will be detrimental to the best interests of the community because such deferral will result in the unnecessary delay of the installation of the sidewalk which is in the best interest of the public for public safety. Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), Ordinance Code, enactment of this ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the Council members present at the meeting because of the CIP amendment set forth in this section. This ordinance shall constitute an amendment to Ordinance 2020-505-E. In all other respects, the Five-Year Capital Improvement Program approved by Ordinance 2020-505-E shall continue in full force and effect.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective

without the Mayor's signature.
