1 Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in 2 Section 1 is to provide funding for an updated comprehensive disparity 3 study. The original disparity study was performed by Mason Tillman 4 Associates, Ltd, in 2013. The JSEB Special Committee has made 5 recommendations in Ordinance 2021-117, currently pending, to update 6 the 2013 study.

7 Section 3. Carryover. The funds appropriated in this 8 ordinance shall not lapse but shall carryover to fiscal year 2021-9 2022.

10 Section 4. Oversight Department. The Procurement Division 11 of the Finance and Administration Department shall select a consultant 12 to provide the updated disparity study pursuant to the provisions of 13 Chapter, 126, Ordinance Code, and shall oversee the completion of the 14 updated study.
