Emergency Rental Assistance Program Eligibility Criteria

Applicants must meet the following requirements to be eligible for receipt of financial assistance through the Emergency Rental Assistance Program. Documentation is required to confirm eligibility.

Eligible applicants must be:

- A U.S. Citizen or Legal Resident Alien
- A resident of Duval County (including the Beaches and Town of Baldwin)
- Delinquent on the payment of rent, certain utilities and/or home energy costs due on or after March 13, 2020
- Part of an "Eligible household" as defined by the Act as follows:
 - Household must include one (1) or more individuals who are obligated to pay rent on a residential dwelling in Duval County; and
 - The City must also make a determination that:
 - One (1) or more individuals within the household has
 - (i) qualified for unemployment benefits, or
 - (ii) experienced a reduction in household income, incurred significant costs, or experienced other financial hardship due, directly or indirectly, to COVID-19 and can attest to such in writing;
 - One (1) or more individuals within the household can demonstrate a risk of experiencing homelessness or housing instability, which may include
 - (i) a past due utility or rent notice or eviction notice;
 - (ii) unsafe or unhealthy living conditions; or
 - (iii) any other evidence of such risk, as determined by the City; and
 - The household has a household income that is not more than 80% of the area median income for the household
