Issuance of this amendment does **not** approve, 14 promote or condone any practice or act that is prohibited or 15 restricted by any federal, state or local laws.

16 Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become 17 effective upon the signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective 18 without the Mayor's signature.
