AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE PROPOSED 2021B SERIES TEXT AMENDMENT TO THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS ELEMENT OF THE 2030 COMPREHENSIVE PLAN OF THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE, TO REMOVE THE MOBILITY FEE CALCULATION FROM THE 2030 COMPREHENSIVE PLAN AND REFERENCE THE MOBILITY FEE CALCULATION IN THE ORDINANCE CODE, FOR TRANSMITTAL TO THE STATE OF FLORIDA'S VARIOUS AGENCIES FOR REVIEW; PROVIDING A DISCLAIMER THAT THE AMENDMENT TRANSMITTED HEREIN SHALL <u>NOT</u> BE CONSTRUED AS AN EXEMPTION FROM ANY OTHER APPLICABLE LAWS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

19 WHEREAS, the Planning and Development Department has initiated 20 certain revisions and modifications to the text of the 2030 21 Comprehensive Plan in accordance with the procedures and requirements 22 set forth in Chapter 650, Part 4, Ordinance Code, to remove the 23 mobility fee calculation from the 2030 Comprehensive Plan and 24 reference the mobility fee calculation in the Ordinance Code, which 25 are more particularly set forth in Revised Exhibit 1, attached hereto, 26 dated February 2, 2021, and incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, the Jacksonville Planning Commission, as the Local Planning Agency, held a public hearing on this proposed Amendment to the 2030 Comprehensive Plan, with due public notice having been provided, and reviewed and considered all comments received during the public hearing, and made a recommendation to the City Council; and

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2 WHEREAS, the Land Use and Zoning (LUZ) Committee held a public 3 hearing on this proposed Amendment pursuant to Chapter 650, Part 4, 4 Ordinance Code, and having considered all written and oral comments 5 received during the public hearing, has made its recommendation to 6 the Council; and

7 WHEREAS, the City Council held a public hearing on this proposed 8 Amendment with public notice having been provided, pursuant to Section 9 163.3184(3), Florida Statutes, and Chapter 650, Part 4, Ordinance 10 Code, and having considered all written and oral comments received 11 during the public hearing, the recommendations of the Planning and 12 Development Department, the Planning Commission and the LUZ 13 Committee, desires to transmit this proposed Amendment through the 14 State's expedited state review process to the Florida Department of 15 Economic Opportunity, as the State Land Planning Agency, the Northeast 16 Florida Regional Council, the Florida Department of Transportation, 17 the St. Johns River Water Management District, the Florida Department 18 of Environmental Protection, the Florida Fish and Wildlife 19 Conservation Commission, the Department of State's Bureau of Historic 20 Preservation, the Florida Department of Education, and the Department 21 of Agriculture and Consumer Affairs; now, therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council for the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Approval of Amendment for Transmittal Purposes. The Council hereby approves the proposed 2021B Series Text Amendment to the Capital Improvements Element of the 2030 Comprehensive Plan, as set forth in Revised Exhibit 1, attached hereto, dated February 2, 2021, for transmittal to Florida's various required State Agencies for review.

Section 2. Disclaimer. The transmittal approved herein shall <u>not</u> be construed as an exemption from any other applicable local, state, or federal laws, regulations, requirements, permits or

approvals. All other applicable local, state or federal permits or 1 2 approvals shall be obtained before commencement of the development 3 or use, and transmittal is based upon acknowledgement, representation and confirmation made by the applicant(s), owner(s), developer(s) 4 5 and/or any authorized agent(s) or designee(s) that the subject business, development and/or use will be operated in strict compliance 6 7 with all laws. Transmittal does **not** approve, promote or condone any practice or act that is prohibited or restricted by any federal, 8 9 state or local laws.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon the signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
