RESOLUTION 2021-132-A

A RESOLUTION HONORING THE HEROIC EFFORTS OF THE JACKSONVILLE SHERIFF'S OFFICE AND THE JACKSONVILLE FIRE AND RESCUE DEPARTMENT ON THE DAMES POINT BRIDGE ON FEBRUARY 6, 2021; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, firefighters selflessly dedicate their time to protecting our lives and property, and sometimes they make the ultimate sacrifice while risking their lives to save others; and

WHEREAS, on February 6, 2021, two vehicles collided on the 16 south end of the Dames Point Bridge, resulting in one car going 17 over the concrete barrier wall into the five feet of water. The 18 Florida Highway Patrol, Jacksonville Sheriff's Office ("JSO"), and 19 20 Jacksonville Fire and Rescue Department ("JFRD") responded to the 21 accident. Upon arrival, JFRD's Ladder 30 crew worked tirelessly to 22 rescue the driver. Captain Phillip O'Relli was lowered down the 23 bridge's side upon which he harnessed the driver, and the two men 24 were pulled back to safety; and

WHEREAS, JSO officers were a pivotal part of the rescue in maintaining the flow of traffic to minimize any further incidents, which allowed JFRD to concentrate solely on the rescue. First responders answered to calls of help even though they were placing themselves in danger. They responded with a sense of urgency, purpose, and courage for the safety of others. Although they were doing their job, the heroic efforts of the Ladder 30 crew, JSO, and 1 everyone involved are evidence of dedication and teamwork in the 2 midst of a crisis; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. The City of Jacksonville hereby honors the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office and the Jacksonville Fire and Rescue Department for their heroic efforts on the Dames Point Bridge on February 6, 2021 and expresses its most sincere gratitude to JSO and JFRD for their exemplary service, commitment, and courage to all citizens and visitors of Duval County.

Section 2. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
