RESOLUTION 2021-130-A

A RESOLUTION COMMENDING JIM SCHMITT UPON BEING SELECTED THE 2021 VYSTAR DUVAL COUNTY TEACHER OF THE YEAR; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Jim Schmitt has 28 years of teaching experience, and currently teaches history, global perspectives and research at Mandarin High School in the Cambridge Advanced International Certificate of Education program where he has worked for 11 years; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Schmitt has served as a classroom teacher, a teacher trainer and as an assistant principal in schools all over Duval County, including Raines High, Paxon High and Northwestern Middle Schools. Mr. Schmitt is also a veteran and was a Lieutenant with the U.S. Navy for six years; and

Whereas, during his tenure, Mr. Schmitt has done more than just teach, he also developed a writing program for at-risk students, wrote a \$10,000 grant for a school-to-work program, served as a standards coach and coached championship-winning teams in cross country and track and field; and

WHEREAS, the teacher of the year community-driven selection process is rigorous: each public school nominates one teacher as Teacher of the Year, then the Jacksonville Public Education Fund organizes community selection committees, which include educators, community leaders and business leaders. The committees read teachers' applications, review letters of recommendation from

principals, students and parents, interview semi-finalists and finalists, and observe their work in the classroom; and

WHEREAS, throughout his career, Jim Schmitt has excelled as a teacher leader. When the COVID-19 pandemic began, he took a leadership role in helping teachers collaborate even more, developing a community discussion group to exchange technology strategies that work. Duval County Schools Superintendent Dr. Diana Greene said that Mr. Schmitt epitomizes all that is good and great in Duval County Public Schools; and

WHEREAS, during Mr. Schmitt's acceptance speech at the award ceremony, he acknowledged each of his students by name. He went on to speak about his teaching philosophy, saying that you cannot teach what you don't "grow," noting that teachers' love of students is the difference maker in society, and emphasized that there is no way to reach a student and guide their learning if you haven't set the table with a smile and a kindness. Mr. Schmitt also said that in today's world, with uncertainty and, at times, fear for the future, we as teachers know that our class is a haven of hope for our students; now therefore
