

Staff Report on Proposed 2020B Series' Text Amendment to the Future Land Use Element of 2030 Comprehensive Plan

ORDINANCE 2021-65

As indicated in EXHIBIT 1 for Ordinance 2021-65 a map amendment is being proposed to the Future Land Use Element (FLUE) to update Map L-4, the 100 Year Flood Hazard Area, Flood Zone Map. The revised map identifies the current flood zones with updated data from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA). The map is also included as Map C-1 in the Conservation Coastal Management Element Background Report which is not adopted.

The adoption of the Flood Zone map into the Future Land Use Element is required pursuant to Chapter 163.3177(6)(a), Florida Statutes.

The Planning and Development Department recommends APPROVAL of the text amendment subject to the Revised EXHIBIT 1 dated February 23, 2021 and submitted as Ordinance 2021-65.

ORDINANCE 2021-65

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE 2020B SERIES AMENDMENT TO THE FUTURE LAND USE ELEMENT AND THE CONSERVATION/COASTAL MANAGEMENT ELEMENT OF 2030 COMPREHENSIVE PLANOF THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE, TO UPDATE MAP L-4 AND MAP C-1, THE 100 YEAR FLOOD HAZARD AREA, FLOOD ZONES MAP; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Planning and Development Department has initiated certain revisions and modifications to the text of the 2030 Comprehensive Plan in accordance with the procedures and requirements set forth in Chapter 650, Part 4, Ordinance Code, to facilitate the appropriate and timely implementation of the plan, and has provided the necessary supporting data and analysis to support and justify the amendments determined to be required, and accordingly, has proposed certain revisions and modifications, which are more particularly set forth in Exhibit 1, attached hereto, dated February 3, 2021, and incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, the City, by the adoption of Ordinance 2020-665-E, approved this amendment to the 2030 Comprehensive Plan for transmittal to the Florida Department of Economic Opportunity (DEO), as the State Land Planning Agency, and other required state agencies, for review and comment; and

WHEREAS, by various letters and e-mails, the DEO and other state reviewing agencies transmitted their comments, if any, regarding this proposed amendment to the 2030 Comprehensive Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Planning and Development Department reviewed the

proposed revisions, considered all comments received, prepared a written report and rendered an advisory recommendation to the Council with respect to this proposed amendment to the 2030 Comprehensive Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission, as the Local Planning Agency, held a public hearing on this proposed amendment to the 2030 Comprehensive Plan, with due public notice having been provided, and reviewed and considered all comments received during the public hearing, and made a recommendation to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 650.408 Ordinance Code, the Land Use and Zoning Committee held a public hearing in accordance with the requirements of Chapter 650, Part 4, Ordinance Code, on this proposed amendment to the 2030 Comprehensive Plan, and has made its recommendation to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 163.3184(3), Florida Statutes, and Chapter 650, Part 4, Ordinance Code, the City Council held a public hearing, with public notice having been provided, on this proposed amendment to the 2030 Comprehensive Plan; and

WHEREAS, the City Council further considered all oral and written comments received during the public hearings, including the data collection and analysis portions of this proposed amendment to the 2030 Comprehensive Plan, the recommendations of the Planning and Development Department and the Planning Commission, the final recommendations of the Land Use and Zoning Committee, and the comments, if any, of the DEO and the other state agencies; and

WHEREAS, in the exercise of its authority, the City Council has determined it necessary and desirable to adopt this proposed amendment to the 2030 Comprehensive Plan to preserve and enhance present advantages, encourage the most appropriate use of land, water and resources, consistent with public interest, overcome present deficiencies, and deal effectively with future problems that may

result from the use and development of land within the City of Jacksonville; now, therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Purpose and Intent. This Ordinance is adopted to carry out the purpose and intent of, and exercise the authority set out in, the Local Government Comprehensive Planning and Land Development Regulation Act, Sections 163.3161 through 163.3248, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 166, Florida Statutes, as amended. Use amendment modifies the Future Land Element the Conservation/Coastal Management Element of the 2030 Comprehensive Plan, to update Map L-4 and Map C-1, the 100 Year Flood Hazard Area, Flood Zones Map.

Amendment to Comprehensive Plan. The 2030 Section 2. Comprehensive Plan is hereby amended to include this revision to the text of the Future Land Use Element and the Conservation/Coastal Management Element from the 2020B Series, which has been initiated by the Planning and Development Department, as more particularly set forth in Exhibit 1, attached hereto, dated February 3, 2021, and incorporated herein by reference.

Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become Section 3. effective upon the signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
