7 A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING SENATE BILL 78,
8 DESIGNATING A PORTION OF STATE ROAD U.S.
9 90/BEAVER STREET BETWEEN CHAFFEE ROAD AND U.S.
10 301 IN DUVAL COUNTY AS "JOHN B. COXWELL
11 MEMORIAL HIGHWAY"; DIRECTING THE CHIEF OF
12 LEGISLATIVE SERVICES TO SEND A COPY OF THIS
13 RESOLUTION UPON ADOPTION TO THE FLORIDA
14 DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, DUVAL
15 LEGISLATIVE DELEGATION, THE SENATE PRESIDENT
16 AND THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE; PROVIDING AN
17 EFFECTIVE DATE.
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19 **WHEREAS**, during the 2020 Legislative Session, the Florida
20 Legislature passed Senate Bill 78, which makes honorary
21 designations of transportation facilities through Florida and
22 directs the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) to erect
23 suitable markers for those designations; and

24 **WHEREAS**, Senate Bill 78 designates that portion of State Road
25 U.S. 90/Beaver Street between Chaffee Road and U.S. 301 as "John B.
26 Coxwell Memorial Highway"; and

27 **WHEREAS**, Section 334.071, *Florida Statutes*, provides that a
28 city or county must pass a resolution in support of a particular
29 designation before road markers are erected; and

30 **WHEREAS**, the City of Jacksonville wishes to honor John B.
31 Coxwell and requests that the Florida Department of Transportation

1 erect suitable markers designating a portion of U.S. 90/Beaver
2 Street between Chaffee Road and U.S. 301 in Duval County as "John
3 B. Coxwell Memorial Highway"; now therefore

4 **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

5 **Section 1.** The City Council strongly supports Senate Bill
6 78, and designation of a portion of U.S. 90/Beaver Street between
7 Chaffee Road and U.S. 301 as the "John B. Coxwell Memorial
8 Highway."

9 **Section 2. Direction to Chief of Legislative**
10 **Services.** The Chief of Legislative Services for the City Council is
11 hereby directed to provide a copy of this resolution upon adoption
12 to the Florida Department of Transportation, Duval County
13 Legislative Delegation, Senate President and the Speaker of the
14 House.

15 **Section 3. Effective Date.** That this Resolution shall
16 become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming
17 effective without the Mayor's signature.
