5 AN ORDINANCE REGARDING DOCKLESS MOBILITY
6 PROGRAMS; AMENDING CHAPTER 235 (DOCKLESS
7 MOBILITY PROGRAMS), *ORDINANCE CODE*, SECTION
8 235.104 (DOCKLESS MOBILITY UNIT PILOT PROGRAM
9 PERMITTING) TO AUTHORIZE UP TO SIX OPERATORS AND
10 SECTION 235.105 (DOCKLESS MOBILITY PROGRAM
11 REQUIREMENTS) TO AUTHORIZE UP TO TWELVE DOCKLESS
12 MOBILITY UNITS TO BE STORED IN CORRALS, TO
13 CLARIFY THE ROLE OF THE CITY'S PUBLIC PARKING
14 DIVISION IN ADMINISTERING AND ENFORCING THE
15 DOCKLESS MOBILITY PROGRAM, AND TO PROVIDE THAT
16 UNCLAIMED DOCKLESS MOBILITY UNITS SHALL BECOME
17 CITY PROPERTY IF UNCLAIMED FOR 180 DAYS;
18 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

20 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

21 **Section 1. Amending a Chapter 235 (Dockless Mobility**
22 **Programs), Ordinance Code.** Chapter 235 (Dockless Mobility Programs),
23 *Ordinance Code*, is hereby amended to read as follows:

24 **CHAPTER 235 - DOCKLESS MOBILITY PROGRAMS.**

25 * * *

26 **Sec. 235.104. - Dockless mobility unit pilot program permitting.**

27 (a) It shall be unlawful for an Operator to provide or operate
28 a Dockless mobility program within the City without first obtaining
29 a permit from the Department.

30 (b) No more than ~~four~~ (4) six (6) Operators will be permitted
31 to operate within the City at any time.

2 **Sec. 235.105. - Dockless mobility program requirements.**

4 (b) *Parking and right-of-way.*

5 * * *

6 (8) The Corrals shall be able to contain up to 512 Units at a
7 time. Parking Corrals shall be clearly marked in a manner approved
8 by the City.

9 (9) Any Dockless mobility unit parked in violation of this
10 subsection may be removed by the CityOffice of Public Parking, and
11 the Operator will be assessed a fee as set forth in section 235.107.

13 (d) *Maintenance, operations, and fleet size.*

14 * * *

15 (4) Dockless mobility units that are inoperable/damaged or do
16 not comply with other subsections of this code must be removed within
17 2 hours upon receipt of a complaint between the hours of 7:00 a.m.
18 and 7:00 p.m., seven (7) days per week and within twelve (12) hours
19 upon receipt of a complaint on holidays. An inoperable or damaged
20 Dockless bicycle, Dockless electric bicycle, or Dockless scooter is
21 one that has non-functioning features (i.e., gear selectors, pedals,
22 bell, lights, dead battery) or is missing components (i.e., fenders,
23 grips, chain guards) as applicable to that vehicle. An Operator whose
24 Dockless bicycle, Dockless electric bicycle, or Dockless scooter is
25 inoperable or damaged or that has non-functioning features and which
26 is removed or stored by the CityOffice of Public Parking is subject
27 to the storage fees set forth in section 235.107.

28 (5) The CityOffice of Public Parking, without notice, reserves
29 the right to remove Dockless mobility units from the right-of-way if
30 an emergency arises. In such instances, the CityOffice of Public
31 Parking will attempt to notify the Operator as soon as reasonably

1 practicable thereafter.

2 (6) Operators must detail a plan to relocate the Dockless
3 mobility units to a safe, indoor facility within twenty-four (24)
4 hours in the result of a declared tropical weather event (tropical
5 storm or hurricane watch or warning, whichever comes first). The plan
6 must detail the amount of time it will take to remove all Dockless
7 mobility units from circulation once a storm watch or warning has
8 been established. The ~~City~~Office of Public Parking may remove any
9 Dockless mobility unit that is not relocated as required by this
10 subsection, and the Operator shall be assessed a removal fee as
11 provided in section 235.107.

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13 (12) Scooters not retrieved from the Office of Public Parking
14 within 180 days shall become the property of the City.

16 **Section 2. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become
17 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
18 without the Mayor's signature.
