5 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$761,250.00 IN
6 FEDERAL PASS-THROUGH GRANT FUNDS FROM THE
7 FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO
8 REIMBURSE THE CITY FOR ITS PARTICIPATION IN THE
9 CONSTRUCTION OF SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENTS ON CEDAR
10 POINT ROAD FROM EAST OF GROVER ROAD TO WEST OF
11 BONEY ROAD, AS INITIATED BY B.T. 21-055; PURPOSE
12 OF THE APPROPRIATION; AMENDING THE 2021-2025
13 FIVE-YEAR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN APPROVED BY
14 ORDINANCE 2020-505-E FOR CONSTRUCTION OF
15 SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENTS ON CEDAR POINT ROAD;
16 PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE ENGINEERING AND
17 CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT DIVISION OF THE
18 DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS; PROVIDING AN
19 EFFECTIVE DATE.

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21 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

22 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2020-2021 fiscal year,
23 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated
24 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)
25 listed in subsection (b):

1 (c) Explanation of Appropriation:

2 The funding above is a federal pass-through grant from the
3 Florida Department of Transportation ("FDOT").

4 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
5 Section 1 is to provide pass-through federal grant funding through
6 FDOT from the Highway Planning and Construction Federal-Aid Highway
7 Program, Federal Lands Highway Program (CFDA No. 20.205) to reimburse
8 the City for its participation in the construction of sidewalk
9 improvements on Cedar Point Road from east of Grover Road to west of
10 Boney Road (the "Project"). The City will be providing construction
11 oversight and project management for the Project, which is required
12 to be completed on or before June 30, 2023. A copy of the Local
13 Agency Program Agreement between the City and FDOT has been placed
14 **On File** with the Office of Legislative Services.

15 **Section 3. Capital Improvement Plan Amendment.** Ordinance
16 2020-505-E, adopting the 2021-2025 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan
17 (the "CIP") for the City and certain of its independent agencies, is
18 hereby amended to provide funding for the Project, as more fully
19 described in the Project Information Sheet, attached hereto as **Exhibit**
20 **2** and incorporated herein by this reference. The City Council finds
21 that the deferral of this amendment of the CIP until the next annual
22 budget and CIP review will be detrimental to the best interests of
23 the community because such deferral will result in unnecessary delay
24 of the Project and loss of grant funding for the Project. Pursuant
25 to Section 122.605(c), *Ordinance Code*, enactment of this Ordinance
26 requires the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the City Council
27 members present at the meeting because of the CIP amendment set forth
28 in this section. This Ordinance shall constitute an amendment to
29 Ordinance 2020-505-E. In all other respects, the Five-Year Capital
30 Improvement Plan approved by Ordinance 2020-505-E shall remain
31 unchanged and continue in full force and effect.
