7 ORDINANCE APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING AN THE 8 MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER THAT CERTAIN 9 10 MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND LIBERTY POINT LLC ("LP") FOR 11 MAINTENANCE OF CERTAIN PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS AT 12 13 BERKMAN PLAZA; INVOKING THE EXCEPTION IN 14 SECTION 126.107(G), ORDINANCE CODE, TO ALLOW 15 DIRECT CONTRACT WITH LIBERTY POINT LLC ΤO 16 PROVIDE MAINTENANCE OF CERTAIN PUBLIC 17 IMPROVEMENTS ΑT BERKMAN PLAZA; PROVIDING 18 FURTHER AUTHORIZATIONS; PROVIDING FOR CITY 19 OVERSIGHT ΒY THE DEPARTMENT OF PARKS, 20 RECREATION AND COMMUNITY SERVICES; PROVIDING 21 AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

23 BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville: 24 Section 1. Approval and authorization to execute 25 Maintenance Agreement. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, 26 his designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby or 27 authorized to execute and deliver, for and on behalf of the City, 28 that certain Maintenance Agreement between the City of Jacksonville 29 and Liberty Point LLC (the "Agreement"), in substantially the same 30 form attached hereto as **Revised Exhibit 1**, labeled as "Revised

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Exhibit 1, Revised Agmt, March 15, 2021 - NCSPHS" and incorporated 1 herein by this reference, pursuant to which LP will provide 2 3 maintenance services for certain public improvements at Berkman The Agreement provides for an initial term of ten (10) Plaza. 4 5 years commencing upon the effective date of the Agreement, with the option to renew for up to fifteen (15) additional one (1) year 6 7 The City's total maximum indebtedness for fiscal year 2020terms. is \$126,000.00, payable in quarterly installments to be 8 2021 9 prorated from the date of contract execution in accordance with the terms of the Agreement. The total maximum indebtedness for 10 subsequent years shall be calculated in accordance with a formula 11 outlined in the Agreement, subject to future appropriations by the 12 13 Council.

14 Section 2. Invoking the exception to Section 126.107(g), 15 Ordinance Code. The City is hereby authorized to procure the use of the professional services of Liberty Point LLC 16 to provide 17 maintenance of certain public improvements at Berkman Plaza. Pursuant to Section 126.107(g) (Exemptions), Part 1 (General 18 Regulations), Chapter 126 (Procurement Code), Ordinance Code, such 19 20 procurement is exempted from competitive solicitation because the 21 supplies or services are to be provided by those specifically 22 prescribed within authorizing legislation that appropriates the 23 same. With the exception of the foregoing, all other provisions of 24 Chapter 126, Ordinance Code, shall remain in full force and effect.

Further Authorizations. 25 Section 3. The Mayor, or his 26 designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to 27 execute amendments to the Agreement that include, but are not 28 limited to, revisions to the scope of services that become 29 field conditions or necessary due to changes in applicable maintenance standards or codes, and other minor changes which have 30 no financial impact. No modification of the Agreement may increase 31

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the financial obligations or the liability of the City. The Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute all other contracts and documents and otherwise take all necessary action therewith and herewith, subject to review and approval by the Office of General Counsel, to effectuate the purpose and intent of this ordinance.

7 Section 4. Oversight Department. The Department of
8 Parks, Recreation and Community Services shall oversee
9 administration of the Agreement.

Section 5. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
