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6 **ORDINANCE 2021-140-E**

7 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO ENTER  
8 INTO AN AMENDED AND RESTATED FUNDING AGREEMENT  
9 BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND THE  
10 JACKSONVILLE TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY ("JTA")  
11 TO EXPAND THE "DOOR-TO-STORE PROGRAM" APPROVED  
12 BY ORDINANCE 2021-46-E (THE "PROGRAM"), A  
13 COMPONENT OF THE FULL-SERVICE GROCERY STORE  
14 IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM ESTABLISHED UNDER  
15 ORDINANCE 2019-812-E; PROVIDING FOR CITY  
16 OVERSIGHT AND PROGRAM ADMINISTRATION BY THE  
17 OFFICE OF ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT; REQUESTING ONE  
18 CYCLE EMERGENCY PASSAGE; PROVIDING AN  
19 EFFECTIVE DATE.

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21 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

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23 **Section 1. Approval and authorization for the Amended and**  
24 **Restated Funding Agreement.** There is hereby approved, and the  
25 Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby  
26 authorized to execute and deliver, for and on behalf of the City,  
27 that certain Amended and Restated Funding Agreement between the  
28 City of Jacksonville and the Jacksonville Transportation Authority,  
29 attached hereto as **Exhibit 1** and incorporated herein by this  
30 reference. The purpose of the Amended and Restated agreement is to

1 allow JTA to expand the "Door-To-Store" Program, as approved by  
2 Ordinance 2021-46-E, to provide for an additional drop off site and  
3 to expand the ride area.

4 **Section 2. Oversight Department.** The Office of Economic  
5 Development shall oversee and administer the Program described  
6 herein.

7 **Section 3. Requesting One Cycle Emergency Passage**  
8 **Pursuant to Council Rule 4.901 Emergency.** One cycle emergency  
9 passage of this legislation is requested. The nature of the  
10 emergency is that expansion of the rider area was funded through  
11 Ordinance 2021-46-E and JTA is ready and willing to commence the  
12 new route service but amendment of the agreement must be approved  
13 by Council before JTA can begin the new routes.

14 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become  
15 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
16 without the Mayor's signature.
