Bill Summary: The bill appropriates \$13,500.00 in Department of Homeland Security (DHS) / Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Emergency Food and Shelter Program (EFSP), as initiated by B.T. 21-051; and provides oversight by the Military Affairs and Veterans Department.

Background Information: The appropriation will provide funding for emergency rent, mortgage, and utility assistance for eligible Duval County veterans from the Phase 38 Pass-Through Grant Funds distributed by United Way Worldwide. The program begins January 1, 2020, to October 31, 2021.
