Bill Summary: This bill appropriates \$54,000 in anticipated revenue from the lease of a portion of a city-owned property located at 7600 Bailey Board Road to Thompson Enterprises of Jacksonville, LLC to be used by the Jacksonville Fire and Rescue Department for the purchase of capital firefighting equipment. The Jacksonville Fire and Rescue Department will use these funds to purchase firefighting capital equipment including, but not limited to, thermal imaging cameras, airpacks, extrication equipment and other similar items.

Background Information: The funds appropriated hereunder represent the rent to be collected from the Tenant during the months of January 2021 through September 2021. The City purchased the property and surrounding parcels in December 2020 as the future location of the new Fire Station #65.

Policy Impact Area: Purchase of firefighting equipment

Fiscal Impact: \$54,000 appropriation
